Changeovers will take place at the **BUS STAND** on Townley Road and at Bexleyheath Bus Garage in the evenings. Please check your duty card. **Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.**



Route B13 is a low frequency route. In terms of our performance, it is very important that you are no more than 2 minutes early at any time and when possible, no more than 5 minutes late.

IMPORTANT: Please do your utmost to keep your bus within this 7 minute window unless prevented by traffic or other circumstances beyond your control. A few seconds make a big difference to our performance.





RUNNING OUT OF SERVICE

IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS **IMMEDIATELY** IF RUNNING LIGHT

TO BEXLEYHEATH LIBRARY

- From Bexleyheath Garage, turn left onto Erith Road A220
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Gravel Hill **A207**
- At 2nd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Albion Road A207
- At 3rd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Albion Road **A207**
- At 4th roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Albion Road A207
- Turn right onto Royal Oak Road
- Follow road right onto Townley Road to stand

FROM BEXLEYHEATH LIBRARY

- At stand, continue ahead on Townley Road
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Albion Road **A207**
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Albion Road A207
- At 2nd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Albion Road A207
- At 3rd roundabout, take 1st exit onto Gravel Hill A207
- At 4th roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Erith Road A220
- Turn right into Bexleyheath Garage

RUNNING OUT OF SERVICE

IMPORTANT IMMEDIATELY IF RUNNING LIGHT

TO NEW ELTHAM STATION

- From **Bexleyheath Garage**, turn left onto Erith Road **A220**
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Gravel Hill A207
- At 2nd roundabout, take 1st exit onto Gravel Hill A220
- At 3rd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Bourne Road (over A2) A223
- At 4th roundabout, take 1st exit onto Bourne Road A223
- At mini roundabout, take 1st exit onto Bexley High Street **A223**
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto North Cray Road A223
- At 2nd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto North Cray Road A223
- At 3rd roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Edgington Way **A223**
- Follow road to Crittalls Corner Roundabout
- At Crittalls Corner Roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Sidcup By-Pass slip road
- Join Sidcup By-Pass Road **A20**
- At traffic light, turn right onto Southwood Road (towards New Eltham) to stand

FROM NEW ELTHAM STATION

- At stand, continue ahead on Southwood Road
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Avery Hill Road
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Avery Hill Road B2214
- At traffic light, turn right onto Bexley Road A210
- Continue ahead onto Blackfen Road A210
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Danson Underpass **A221**
- At 2nd roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Lodge Lane (towards Dover A2)
- Join East Rochester Way A2
- At Black Prince Interchange, take exit and continue to roundabout
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Gravel Hill **A220**
- At 2nd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Gravel Hill A220
- At 3rd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Erith Road A220
- At traffic light, continue onto Erith Road and Bexleyheath Garage

- At 3rd mini roundabout, take 1st exit onto Alers Road
- Continue ahead onto Brook Lane
- Turn right onto Sandhurst Road
- At junction, turn left onto Danson Road
- At roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Danson Underpass A221
- At 2nd roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Blackfen Road A210
- Turn left onto Ramillies Road
- At junction, turn right onto Sherwood Park Avenue
- At junction, continue ahead onto Burnt Oak Lane
- At junction, turn left onto Days Lane
- At junction, turn right onto Halfway Street B2214
- Turn left onto Avery Hill Road (just before roundabout)
- At junction, turn left onto Avery Hill Road
- At traffic light, turn right onto Footscray Road (New Eltham Station) A211
- Turn left onto Green Lane **B263**
- At A20 junction, turn left onto Southwood Road to stand

TERMINUS POINT


SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From New Eltham. Proceed from Townley Road, Albion Road, Royal Oak Road, Townley Road to stand. Set down on Townley Road at *BUS STOP Z*.

Towards New Eltham. Depart to Townley Road.

Pick up on Townley Road at BUS STOP Z.

Two stand spaces will operate from the one stop flag (*BUS STOP Z*). Buses should use the available bus stand space and also board and alight from either space. **Blind display:** *BEXLEYHEATH LIBRARY*.



BLENDON ROAD

TURNING POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILSTATTHE STAND


From Bexleyheath. Proceed from Danson Underpass. Set down on Danson Underpass at BUS STOP T.

Towards Bexleyheath. Depart to Danson Underpass. Pick up on Danson Underpass at BUS STOP Q.

From New Eltham. Proceed from Blackfen Road. Set down on Blackfen Road at BUS STOP B.

Towards New Eltham. Depart to Blackfen Road. Pick up on Blackfen Road at BUS STOP N.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: PENHILL, BLENDON ROAD.



AVERY HILL ROAD TURNING POINT


IMPORTANT IF YOU REQUIRE A COMFORT BREAK, PLEASE **ADVISE IBUS**

From Bexleyheath. Proceed from Halfway Street, Avery Hill Road. Set down on Halfway Street at BUS STOP AT.

Towards Bexleyheath. Depart to Halfway Street. Pick up on Halfway Street at BUS STOP AP.

Turning point only - buses must not stand.

Blind display: AVERY HILL ROAD.


HESITATION POINT

From Bexleyheath. Proceed from Southwood Road, Footscray Road, Green Lane, Southwood Road. Set down on Southwood Rd at **BUS STOP D**.

Towards Bexleyheath. Depart to Southwood Road. Pick up on Southwood Road at **BUS STOP D**.

Hail & Ride section between *BUS STOP FE* and *BUS STOP C*. Hesitation point only -Buses should not be scheduled to stand for longer than 2 minutes. Passengers are carried across the terminus. *Blind display: NEW ELTHAM*.



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BUS STAND | BEXLEYHEATH LIBRARY

Care and caution to be taken with oncoming buses when pulling into library stand due to parked vehicles on double yellow lines. Look out for pedestrians. Extra care with street furniture approaching the stand.

ONCOMING VEHICLES | ROYAL OAK ROAD

Reduce speed on the bend, be aware of oncoming buses and vehicles.

PARKED VEHICLES | UPTON ROAD

Parked vehicles on both sides at times. Be aware of parked vehicle on both sides at times and take extra care and time.

VEHICLES ON NEARSIDE LANE | DANSON UNDERPASS

Look out and be aware on vehicles on N/S when taking the 3rd exit onto Danson Underpass and position your bus safely.

VEHICLES ON NEARSIDE LANE | BLACKFEN ROAD

Look out on vehicles on N/S when taking the 3rd exit into Blackfen Road and position your bus safely.

PARKED VEHICLES | RAMILLES RD/SHERWOOD PARK AVE

+ Burnt Oak Lane. Parked vehicles on both sides at times. Be aware of parked vehicle on both sides at times and take extra care and time.

ONCOMING BUSES | BURNT OAK LANE

Take extra care with oncoming buses or large vehicles.

TIGHT TURN DAYS LANE

Take extra care when taking left turn onto Days Lane, extra room needed, be aware of oncoming vehicles. Care and caution with parked vehicles both sides.

20 MPH ZONE | HALFWAY STREET

Care and caution with good observation required. Speed limit is 20 mph. Extra care with oncoming vehicles on our lane, due to parked vehicles on their side.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PARKED VEHICLES | SANDHURST ROAD

+ Mount Road. Parked vehicles on both sides at times. Be aware of parked vehicle on both sides at times and take extra care and time.

TIGHT RIGHT TURN | FOOTSCRAY ROAD

Look out on vehicles on N/S when turning right onto Footscray and position your bus safely.

HAIL & RIDE SECTION | SOUTHWOOD ROAD/GREEN LANE

Bus stop FA to stop C. Extra care and caution, stop only where it is safe to do so.

SCHOOLS EN ROUTE | THROUGHOUT ROUTE

Days Lane Primary School, St Olaves School, Townley Grammar School, James Mar School, Blackfen School for Girls. Look out for pedestrians and parked cars specially at peak times, slow on approach during schools starting and finishing times in preparation to stop safely.

FACILITIES | THROUGHOUT THE ROUTE

- **Bexleyheath Library.** (Open Monday-Wednesday 0930-1730, Thursday 0930-1900 and Saturday 0930-1700).
- Brewers Fayre (on Albion Road near Townley Road stand).

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you see *** displayed on the MDT screen to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
