


ASK AT THE FRONT COUNTER

CHANGEOVER | GARRATT LANE TOOTING BROADWAY

Garratt Lane at <u>BUS STOP N</u> towards Victoria and <u>BUS STOP M</u> towards Tooting. Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.







Route 44 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

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



Public stand for 4 buses on north-east side (offside) of western arm of Grosvenor Gardens. **Blind display:** VICTORIA.





Pick up on Battersea Park Road at BUS STOP LD.

Public stand for two buses on west side of Battersea Bridge Road. **Blind display:** *BATTERSEA, LATCHMERE ROAD.*




WANDSWORTH TURNING POINT

From Victoria. Proceed from Fairfield Street via Wandsworth High Street, Wandsworth Plain and Armoury Way. Set down on Fairfield Street at BUS STOP M.

Towards Victoria. Depart to Old York Road. Pick up on Old York Road at BUS STOP K.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: WANDSWORTH.




WANDSWORTH TURNING POINT

Towards Tooting. Depart to Fairfield Street. Pick up on Fairfield Street at *BUS STOP M*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. **Blind display:** WANDSWORTH.




WANDSWORTH **CURTAILMENT POINT**

From Victoria. Proceed from Garratt Lane via Mapleton Crescent and Mapleton Road to stand. Set down on Garratt Lane at BUS STOP S.

Towards Victoria. Depart via Mapleton Road to Garratt Lane. Pick up on Garratt Lane at BUS STOP.

Public stand for six buses on north side of Mapleton Road. Blind display: WANDSWORTH.



From Victoria. Proceed from Garratt Lane via Tooting Broadway and Longmead Road to stand. Set down on Garratt Lane at **BUS STOP M**.

Towards Victoria. Depart via Longmead Road (triangular manoeuvre junction of), Longmead Road and Tooting Broadway to Garratt Lane. Pick up on Garratt Lane at *BUS STOP N*.

Public stand for five buses in Longmead Road in three parts. 1. On north side of Longmead Road for three buses. 2. In the centre of Longmead Road for one bus. 3. On south side of Longmead Road for one bus **Blind display:** TOOTING BROADWAY.



TOOTING STATION

TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Victoria. Proceed from Mitcham Road via Longley Road to stand. Set down on Mitcham Road at **BUS STOP TT**.

Towards Victoria. Depart via Longley Road, Bickersteth Road and Renmuir Street to Mitcham Road. Pick up on Mitcham Road at *BUS STOP TD*.

Public stand for two buses on south side of Longley Road. **Blind display:** *TOOTING STATION*.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



TIGHT TURN | RENMUIR STREET

Too tight to approach as left turn Renmuir Street must only be entered using a right turn manoeuvre.

PARKED VEHICLES | RENMUIR STREET

Parking on both sides of the road and speed tables. Drive slowly over speed tables. Be aware of clearance distance from parked wide vehicles.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | MITCHAM ROAD

Parked vehicles, speed tables. Drive slowly and ensure there is enough road space to proceed. Be careful to look out for pedestrians stepping into the path of the bus. Drive over speed tables slowly and with care to avoid poor ride quality, injury to passengers and damage to the vehicle.

TIGHT TURN | CHARLMONT RD JUNC BRIGHTWELL CRES

(Mitre curtailment only) Tight left turn and parked vehicles. The left turn from Charlmont Road onto Brightwell Crescent needs to be taken wide – check the road ahead is clear before manoeuvring and be aware of vehicles parked, especially near corners.

MERGING LANES | GARRATT LANE JUNC MITCHAM ROAD

Two lanes merge into one across junction in both directions. Take care in both directions when crossing this junction. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the one side of the junction become one on the other. Be aware of other vehicle movements on your offside.

'S' BEND | GARRATT LANE JUNC CAMBOLE ROAD

Double bend. Drive slowly and ensure you maintain carriageway position.

SUNKEN DRAIN GARRATT LN JUNC STREATHAM CEMETERY

Sunken drain at bus stop (SA) towards Victoria Station. Be aware of high kerb at the bus stop.

SUNKEN DRAIN | GARRATT LN JUNC WIMBLEDON RD

Sunken drain on approaching bus stop (SB) towards Victoria station. Be aware of high kerb at the bus stop.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LIMITED PAVEMENT ACCESS | FAIRLIGHT RD BUS STOP HR

Towards Victoria, this stop has limited space. If another bus is serving the stop you may need to hold back. Ensure you do not alight passengers onto pavement that is inaccessible due to barriers.

PARKED VEHICLES | GARRATT LANE

Between Wimbledon Road and Summerstown, road space is restricted by parked vehicles. Take care to ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

PARKED VEHICLES | SUMMERSTOWN

(Wimbledon Road curtailments). Road space can be restricted by parked vehicles, especially in evenings. Ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

PARKED VEHICLES | GARRATT LANE

Take care to ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

TRAFFIC ISLANDS | GARRATT LANE JUNC MAGDALEN RD

In both directions, the approach to this junction consists of two lanes whilst the exit reduces to one lane. There are also traffic islands which limit the ability of a bus and another vehicle to travel through the junction together. Be aware of traffic on your offside which may speed to try and get ahead of you – in this scenario hold back and drive defensively. Use a hand signal as well as indicators to make your intentions clearer. **This is a hotspot for minor collisions.**

NARROW ROAD | GARRATT LANE JUNC EARLSFIELD RD

Be aware that the lanes are narrow at this location, especially under the railway bridge. Be aware of traffic on your offside.

MERGING LANES | GARRATT LANE JUNC KIMBER ROAD

Two lanes merge into one. Take care towards Victoria when crossing this junction. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the south of the junction become one on the north. Be aware of other vehicle movements on both sides.



BEDFORD HILL CLEARANCE HEIGHT

DOUBLE DECK VEHICLES MUST NOT BE USED ON THIS ROAD

Junction of Bedford Hill and Balham Station Road in Balham

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

TRAFFIC ISLAND | KIMBER RD AND ALLFARTHING LA

Parking both sides of the road, traffic islands Ensure that there is enough room to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles. If your path is blocked by a large or badly parked vehicle by a traffic island, proceed on the opposite side of the road, if possible with great care. **Code Blue** should be done if this occurs.

CONTRAFLOW BUS LANE | GARRATT LANE JUNC RAM ST

Use headlights. Be careful when entering Ram Street – it is a bus only manoeuvre and pedestrians often cross into the path of an oncoming bus. Use headlights in the contraflow bus lane.

SUNKEN DRAINS GARRATT LANE JUNC MAPLETON RD

Sunken drains on approach to northbound bus stop. Needs to be approached at very slow speed to avoid an unsteady ride that could imbalance passengers.

PARKED VEHICLES | FAIRFIELD STREET JUNC HIGH STREET

Traffic from East Hill has a green light at the same time as traffic from Fairfield St, creating an unclear priority. Approach this junction slowly. Be aware of traffic coming from East Hill. Check path is clear before proceeding through junction.

CYCLISTS | CYCLE SUPERHIGHWAY [CS8]

Be aware of the number of cyclists riding on the blue surfaced. Some places runs inside bus lanes and cuts across bus stops, particularly during peak periods. When pulling away from bus stops, be careful of cyclists overtaking.

PARKED VEHICLES | OLD YORK ROAD

Parking on both sides of the road. Ensure that there is enough room to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles. Call **Code Blue** if obstructed.

BLIND BEND | OLD YORK ROAD

Drive slowly, ensure you maintain correct carriageway position and look out for oncoming vehicles.

OFFSIDE LANE | YORK ROAD JUNC PLOUGH ROAD

Offside lane is for right turn and straight ahead – traffic suddenly changes lanes. Towards Victoria, traffic from the offside lane often suddenly changes road position to nearside lane to travel straight ahead. Approach junction with care and be aware of traffic on your offside.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LANE DISCIPLINE YORK ROAD JUNC PLOUGH ROAD

Two lanes merge into one. Take care towards Tooting, when crossing this junction. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the east of the junction become one on the west. Be aware of other vehicle movements on your offside.

LAY-BY BUS STOP YORK RD JUNCYORK GDNS BUS STOP

Eastbound bus stop. Need to proceed from lay-by bus stop to centre lane. Fast travelling vehicles. Be aware of traffic on your offside when leaving this bus stop especially when the traffic lights at the junction of Lombard Road are green – use a hand signal to give other vehicles a greater knowledge of your intentions.

LOW BRIDGE 10'9" | LOMBARD ROAD

Do not enter Lombard Road in a double deck vehicle under any circumstances.

NARROW ROAD | HIGH STREET JUNC BATTERSEA PARK RD

Drive carefully at this junction and be aware of vehicles on both sides of you.

LOW BRIDGE 11'6" | LATCHMERE ROAD

Do not enter Lombard Road in a double deck vehicle under any circumstances.

TIGHT TURN LOMBARD ROAD

Tight left turn. Towards Victoria, this manoeuvre should be made very slowly, ensuring you carefully adopt the correct road position.

NEW ROAD LAYOUT | QUEENSTOWN ROAD

Need to reach offside lane in limited road space after serving Battersea Park Station bus stop towards Tooting. Take care that your offside is clear before manoeuvring and use a hand signal to give other motorists a clearer indication of your need to change road position.

TEMP BUS STOP | CHELSEA BRIDGE RD / EBURY BRIDGE RD

Temporary Bus stop sited on Permit parking Zone. Tight turning manoeuvres Be careful when serving this stop. Do not pull in to the kerb past the parking zone or illegally park on the zig zags. In both directions, be aware of the road position of other vehicles – drive slowly and hold back if your available road space is limited.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BEND | BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD

The approach and exit from this junction is on a bend and your sight of oncoming traffic is limited. There is also parking on both sides. Approach at a slow speed – check the road ahead is clear before proceeding.

PARKED VEHICLES VICTORIA COACH STATION

Parked cars and coaches around road and bus stops. Drive slowly and be aware that pedestrians may step out from in-between parked vehicles.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD

This junction should be approached at slow speed. Be aware of pedestrians stepping into the path of the bus and tourists that may look the wrong way for oncoming traffic.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | VICTORIA STATION AREA

Vehicle movement area. Drive very slowly and be aware of pedestrians that may step into the road into the path of your bus.

UPGRADE PROJECT | VICTORIA STATION AREA

Victoria Station upgrade project - ongoing road works and lane restrictions. Where the carriageway is reduced by road works, drive slowly and be aware of other vehicles around you and pedestrians that may step into your path.

UPGRADE PROJECT GROSVENOR GARDENS

Victoria Station upgrade project - on-going road works and lane restrictions. Take care using contraflow bus lane at the north end of Buckingham Palace Road before turning left into Grosvenor Gardens. Use headlights in the bus lane and look out for pedestrians and particularly tourist in the area. Take extra caution when stepping off the bus as it is o/s bus stand. High-vis must be worn.

LOW BRIDGE12'3" | BEDFORD HILL OFF BALHAM HIGH RD

Light run route. Double deck vehicles should not be driven along Bedford Hill south of the junction with Balham Station Road.

LOW BRIDGE14'3" | BEDFORD ROAD CLAPHAM NORTH

Double deck vehicles should not be driven along Bedford Road.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.

Garratt Lane at BUS STOP N towards Victoria and BUS STOP M towards Tooting. Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.

TIGHT TURN | RENMUIR STREET

Too tight to approach as left turn Renmuir Street must only be entered using a right turn manoeuvre.

PARKED VEHICLES | RENMUIR STREET

Parking on both sides of the road and speed tables. Drive slowly over speed tables. Be aware of clearance distance from parked wide vehicles.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | MITCHAM ROAD

Parked vehicles, speed tables. Drive slowly and ensure there is enough road space to proceed. Be careful to look out for pedestrians stepping into the path of the bus. Drive over speed tables slowly and with care to avoid poor ride quality, injury to passengers and damage to the vehicle.

TIGHT TURN | CHARLMONT RD JUNC BRIGHTWELL CRES

(Mitre curtailment only) Tight left turn and parked vehicles. The left turn from Charlmont Road onto Brightwell Crescent needs to be taken wide – check the road ahead is clear before manoeuvring and be aware of vehicles parked, especially near corners.

MERGING LANES GARRATT LANE JUNC MITCHAM ROAD

Two lanes merge into one across junction in both directions. Take care in both directions when crossing this junction. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the one side of the junction become one on the other. Be aware of other vehicle movements on your offside.

'S' BEND | GARRATT LANE JUNC CAMBOLE ROAD

Double bend. Drive slowly and ensure you maintain carriageway position.

SUNKEN DRAIN GARRATT LN JUNC STREATHAM CEMETERY

Sunken drain at bus stop (SA) towards Victoria Station. Be aware of high kerb at the bus stop.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

SUNKEN DRAIN GARRATT LN JUNCWIMBLEDON RD

Sunken drain on approaching bus stop (SB) towards Victoria station. Be aware of high kerb at the bus stop.

LIMITED PAVEMENT ACCESS | FAIRLIGHT RD BUS STOP HR

Towards Victoria, this stop has limited space. If another bus is serving the stop you may need to hold back. Ensure you do not alight passengers onto pavement that is inaccessible due to barriers.

PARKED VEHICLES | GARRATT LANE

Between Wimbledon Road and Summerstown, road space is restricted by parked vehicles. Take care to ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

PARKED VEHICLES | SUMMERSTOWN

(Wimbledon Road curtailments). Road space can be restricted by parked vehicles, especially in evenings. Ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

PARKED VEHICLES | GARRATT LANE

Take care to ensure there is enough road space to proceed.

TRAFFIC ISLANDS | GARRATT LANE JUNC MAGDALEN RD

In both directions, the approach to this junction consists of two lanes whilst the exit reduces to one lane. There are also traffic islands which limit the ability of a bus and another vehicle to travel through the junction together. Be aware of traffic on your offside which may speed to try and get ahead of you – in this scenario hold back and drive defensively. Use a hand signal as well as indicators to make your intentions clearer. **This is a hotspot for minor collisions.**

NARROW ROAD | GARRATT LANE JUNC EARLSFIELD RD

Be aware that the lanes are narrow at this location, especially under the railway bridge. Be aware of traffic on your offside.

MERGING LANES | GARRATT LANE JUNC KIMBER ROAD

Two lanes merge into one. Take care towards Victoria when crossing this junction. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the south of the junction become one on the north. Be aware of other vehicle movements on both sides.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

TRAFFIC ISLAND | KIMBER RD AND ALLFARTHING LA

Parking both sides of the road, traffic islands Ensure that there is enough room to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles. If your path is blocked by a large or badly parked vehicle by a traffic island, proceed on the opposite side of the road, if possible with great care. **Code Blue** should be done if this occurs.

CONTRAFLOW BUS LANE | GARRATT LANE JUNC RAM ST

Use headlights. Be careful when entering Ram Street – it is a bus only manoeuvre and pedestrians often cross into the path of an oncoming bus.

SUNKEN DRAINS GARRATT LANE JUNC MAPLETON RD

Sunken drains on approach to northbound bus stop. Needs to be approached at very slow speed to avoid an unsteady ride that could imbalance passengers.

PARKED VEHICLES | FAIRFIELD STREET JUNC HIGH STREET

Traffic from East Hill has a green light at the same time as traffic from Fairfield St, creating an unclear priority. Approach this junction slowly. Be aware of traffic coming from East Hill. Check path is clear before proceeding through junction.

CYCLISTS | CYCLE SUPERHIGHWAY [CS8]

Be aware of the number of cyclists riding on the blue surfaced. Some places runs inside bus lanes and cuts across bus stops, particularly during peak periods. When pulling away from bus stops, be careful of cyclists overtaking.

PARKED VEHICLES | OLD YORK ROAD

Parking on both sides of the road. Ensure that there is enough room to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles. Call Code Blue if obstructed.

BLIND BEND | OLD YORK ROAD

Drive slowly, ensure you maintain correct carriageway position and look out for oncoming vehicles.

OFFSIDE LANE YORK ROAD JUNC PLOUGH ROAD

Offside lane is for right turn and straight ahead – traffic suddenly changes lanes. Towards Victoria, traffic from the offside lane often suddenly changes road position to nearside lane to travel straight ahead. Approach junction with care and be aware of traffic on your offside.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LANE DISCIPLINE YORK ROAD JUNC PLOUGH ROAD

Two lanes merge into one. Take care towards Tooting, when crossing this junction. Lane priority is unclear as two lanes from the east of the junction become one on the west. Be aware of other vehicle movements on your offside.

LAY-BY BUS STOP YORK RD JUNCYORK GDNS BUS STOP

Eastbound bus stop. Need to proceed from lay-by bus stop to centre lane. Fast travelling vehicles. Be aware of traffic on your offside when leaving this bus stop especially when the traffic lights at the junction of Lombard Road are green – use a hand signal to give other vehicles a greater knowledge of your intentions.

LOW BRIDGE 10'9" LOMBARD ROAD

Do not enter Lombard Road in a double deck vehicle under any circumstances.

NARROW ROAD | HIGH STREET JUNC BATTERSEA PARK RD

Drive carefully at this junction and be aware of vehicles on both sides of you.

LOW BRIDGE 11'6" | LATCHMERE ROAD

Do not enter Lombard Road in a double deck vehicle under any circumstances.

TIGHT TURN | LOMBARD ROAD

Tight left turn. Towards Victoria, this manoeuvre should be made very slowly, ensuring you carefully adopt the correct road position.

NEW ROAD LAYOUT | QUEENSTOWN ROAD

Need to reach offside lane in limited road space after serving Battersea Park Station bus stop towards Tooting. Take care that your offside is clear before manoeuvring and use a hand signal to give other motorists a clearer indication of your need to change road position.

TEMP BUS STOP | CHELSEA BRIDGE RD / EBURY BRIDGE RD

Temporary Bus stop sited on Permit parking Zone. Tight turning manoeuvres Be careful when serving this stop. Do not pull in to the kerb past the parking zone or illegally park on the zig zags. In both directions, be aware of the road position of other vehicles – drive slowly and hold back if your available road space is limited.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BEND | BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD

The approach and exit from this junction is on a bend and your sight of oncoming traffic is limited. There is also parking on both sides. Approach at a slow speed – check the road ahead is clear before proceeding.

PARKED VEHICLES VICTORIA COACH STATION

Parked cars and coaches around road and bus stops. Drive slowly and be aware that pedestrians may step out from in-between parked vehicles.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD

This junction should be approached at slow speed. Be aware of pedestrians stepping into the path of the bus and tourists that may look the wrong way for oncoming traffic.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | VICTORIA STATION AREA

Vehicle movement area. Drive very slowly and be aware of pedestrians that may step into the road into the path of your bus.

UPGRADE PROJECT | VICTORIA STATION AREA

Victoria Station upgrade project - ongoing road works and lane restrictions. Where the carriageway is reduced by road works, drive slowly and be aware of other vehicles around you and pedestrians that may step into your path.

UPGRADE PROJECT GROSVENOR GARDENS

Victoria Station upgrade project - on-going road works and lane restrictions. Take care using contraflow bus lane at the north end of Buckingham Palace Road before turning left into Grosvenor Gardens. Use headlights in the bus lane and look out for pedestrians and particularly tourist in the area. Take extra caution when stepping off the bus as it is o/s bus stand. High-vis must be worn.

LOW BRIDGE12'3" | BEDFORD HILL OFF BALHAM HIGH RD

Light run route. Double deck vehicles should not be driven along Bedford Hill south of the junction with Balham Station Road.

LOW BRIDGE 14'3" | BEDFORD ROAD CLAPHAM NORTH

Double deck vehicles should not be driven along Bedford Road.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
