THINGS TO REMEMBER MAKE NOTES ALONG THE WAY!

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Route 131 is a High-Frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

- Continue ahead onto Tooting High Street A24
- At traffic light, turn right onto Mitcham Road (Tooting Broadway Station) A217
- Turn left onto Longmead Road to **stand**

FROM TOOTING BROADWAY:

- At stand, continue ahead on Longmead Road
- Turn right onto Mitcham Road **A217**
- At traffic light, turn left onto Tooting High Street (Tooting Broadway Stn) **A24**
- Continue ahead onto High Street Colliers Wood A24
- Continue ahead onto Merton High Street A238
- Turn right into *Merton Garage*


KINGSTON TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Tooting Broadway. Proceed from Fairfield North via Fairfield Bus Station to stand. Set down on Fairfield North at *BUS STOP B2*.

Towards Tooting Broadway. Depart via Fairfield Bus Station to Fairfield North. Pick up on Fairfield North at *BUS STOP B1*.

Private stand for seven buses in marked bays in Fairfield Bus Station on south side of Fairfield North. Buses must be fitted with an audible reverse warning device. **Blind display:** KINGSTON.



NEW MALDEN CURTAILMENT POINT

PLEASE CHECK TRIP NUMBER

From Tooting Broadway. Proceed from Burlington Road via Fountain Roundabout, Kingston Road and Charnwood Close to stand. Set down on Kingston Hill at *BUS STOP G*.

Towards Tooting Broadway. Depart via Charnwood Close, Kingston Road and Fountain Roundabout to Burlington Road. Pick up on Kingston Hill at *BUS STOP F*.

Public stand for three buses in bay on north side of Kingston Road. **Blind display:** NEW MALDEN, FOUNTAIN ROUNDABOUT.




NEW MALDEN TURNING POINT

From Tooting Broadway. Proceed from Burlington Road via Fountain Roundabout. Set down on Burlington Road at *BUS STOP G*.

Towards Tooting Broadway. Depart to Burlington Road. Pick up on Burlington Road at *BUS STOP F*.

Turning point only - Buses must not stand. **Blind display:** NEW MALDEN, FOUNTAIN ROUNDABOUT.

From Tooting Broadway. Proceed from Burlington Road via Shannon Corner. Set down on Burlington Road at *BUS STOP R*.

Towards Tooting Broadway. Depart to Burlington Road. Pick up on Burlington Road at *BUS STOP C*.

Turning point only - Buses must not stand. Blind display: SHANNON CORNER.



Towards Tooting Broadway. Depart to Worple Road. Pick up on Worple Road at *BUS STOP D*.

From Kingston. Proceed from Coombe Lane via Lambton Rd, Worple Road and Pepys Rd. Set down on Coombe Lane at **BUS STOP B**.

Towards Kingston. Depart to Coombe Ln. Pick up on Coombe Ln at BUS STOP H.

Turning point only - Buses must not stand. Blind display: RAYNES PARK.




WIMBLEDON TURNING POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Tooting Broadway. Proceed from Hartfield Road via Wimbledon Bridge, St George's Road and Francis Grove. Set down on Hartfield Road at **BUS STOP L**.

Towards Tooting Broadway. Depart to Worple Road. Pick up on Worple Road at *BUS STOP N*.

Turning point only - Buses must not stand. Blind display: WIMBLEDON.




WIMBLEDON TURNING POINT

Turning point only - Buses must not stand. Blind display: WIMBLEDON.




COLLIERS WOOD TURNING POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Kingston. Proceed from Merton High Street via Priory Road to stand. Set down on Merton High Street at *BUS STOP E*.

Towards Kingston. Depart via Priory Road, Christchurch Road and Collier's Wood High Street to Merton High Street. Pick up on Merton High Street at *BUS STOP G*.

Turning point only - Buses must not stand. Blind display: COLLIERS WOOD.


SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Kingston. Proceed from Tooting High Street via Tooting Broadway, Longmead Road and Tooting Broadway. Set down on Tooting High Street at **BUS STOP L**.

Towards Kingston. Depart via Longmead Road and Tooting Broadway to Tooting High Street. Pick up on Tooting High Street at **BUS STOP K**.

Public stand for five buses in Longmead Rd in three parts.

(1) On north side of Longmead Rd for three buses. (2) In the centre of Longmead Rd for one bus. (3) On south side of Longmead Rd for one bus. **Blind display:** *TOOTING BROADWAY.*

CHANGEOVER | MERTON HIGH STREET

Please read your duty card carefully for the changeover location:
Changeovers will take place on Merton High Street outside the garage
Towards Tooting Broadway: **Stop E**. Towards Kingston: **Stop G**.
Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA KINGSTON FAIRFIELD BUS STN

Possible need to reverse vehicle to stand. Metal bell sited to the left on exit. Use maximum speed of 10 MPH. Be very careful of pedestrians stepping into path of bus and other bus movements, especially when reversing. When exiting be sure to check your nearside mirror to ensure clearance of bell.

20 MPH ZONE | EDEN STREET

Heavy activity of pedestrians waiting for buses and crossing between buses serving bus stops. Heavy bus and other vehicle activity. Take care when proceeding through, observing the 20 MPH speed limit. Special care needed for pedestrians crossing and cyclists.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | CROMWELL ROAD

Congested bus stops especially at peak times with school children who may venture out onto the road as buses approach. Extreme care to be taken when approaching Cromwell Road bus station. Be vigilant for late tending passengers who may want your bus when leaving the stop. Also taking care that your offside exit route is clear of vehicle activity before pulling away.

NARROW ROAD | QUEEN ELIZABETH ROAD

Narrow lanes on bend. Large vehicles will often straddle lanes. Vehicles cutting into your lane at the last minute. Pedestrian crossing at junction. Proceed with caution. Ensure ample room when proceeding on the nearside. Beware of pedestrians waiting to use the crossing especially when school children leave.

NARROW ROAD | CAMBRIDGE ROAD

Lane narrowed considerably reduced because of bus lane on the offside and nearside. Proceed with extreme caution when entering the bus lane checking for vehicle and cyclist activity on your offside and nearside.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LOW BRIDGE | LONDON ROAD/COOMBE ROAD

Under no circumstances must you enter Coombe Road at the junction of London Road. 12.0 ft low bridge on Coombe Road near Kingston Hospital.

TURNING LEFT | CAMBRIDGE ROAD/LONDON ROAD

Turning Left onto London Road from Cambridge Road. Two Lanes, left lane to turn left and right lane to turn only right. Cars turning left from right hand lane. Proceed with caution looking out for potential vehicles turning left.

LOW TREES | KINGSTON ROAD

Proceed with caution. Low hanging branches especially in wet weather.

CYCLE LANE | KINGSTON ROAD

Narrow lane. Risk of collision. Be vigilant when passing cyclists on this stretch of the road, ensuring enough clearance.

STADIUM KINGSTON ROAD/JACK GOODCHILD WAY

AFC Wimbledon Football Stadium – Extra vehicle/pedestrian activity. Proceed with extreme care and caution on match days, looking out for pedestrians walking onto the road between parked cars.

PARKED VEHICLES BURLINGTON ROAD

Parked vehicles on both sides. Proceed with caution when passing.

RAISED SPEED TABLE BURLINGTON ROAD

Risk of damage to vehicle and risk of discomfort/injury to passengers. Reduce speed on approach to minimise discomfort to passengers and avoid damage to bus.

SCHOOL CHILDREN BURLINGTON ROAD

Burlington Road Junior School. Heavy vehicle and pedestrian activity especially when school finishes. Extreme care and caution on approach to school. Look out for any pedestrians/children who may be trying to cross.

RETAIL STORE BURLINGTON ROAD

B&Q Superstore. Vehicles entering and leaving car park. Be aware of vehicles entering and exiting entrance of car park.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LEVEL CROSSING BURLINGTON ROAD

Vehicles from opposite direction turning right in West Barnes Lane. Vehicles exiting left into Burlington Rd. High risk of collision. When approaching this junction you must give way. Proceed with extreme caution when clear to cross junction.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | WEST BARNES LANE

Raynes Park High School. Extreme care and caution on approach to school. Look out for any pedestrians/children who may be trying to cross.

CYCLE LANE | WEST BARNES LANE

Risk of collision. Be vigilant when passing cyclists on this stretch of road, ensuring enough clearance.

TIGHT LEFT TURN COOMBE LANE/WEST BARNES LANE

Tight left turn towards Kingston. Queuing traffic in offside lane. Traffic signal pedestrian crossing. Risk of collision. Proceed with extreme care and caution.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | RAYNES PARK STATION

Pedestrian activity at peak times exiting/entering station using crossing. Risk of collision when pulling out from bus stop in both directions due to vehicles facing traffic island. Risk of vehicles cutting in front of buses. Proceed with extreme caution when approaching pedestrian crossing. Ensure you check your offside mirror when pulling away from the bus stop that your exit is clear.

EMERGING TRAFFIC | COOMBE LANE/RAYNES PARK

Traffic emerging from under bridge to join carriageway from your nearside onto Coombe Lane. Cycle parking racks situated between bus stop and pedestrian crossing close to kerb. Beware and check your nearside when passing this bridge for vehicles joining your lane from under bridge. Beware of cyclists parking or unlocking cycles and joining the carriageway from pavement.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | WORPLE ROAD

High volume of school children at bus stops during start/finish of schools. Risk of surge forcing children into road. Painted cycle lanes. Approach these bus stops with extreme caution. Check nearside for latecomers before pulling away. Check nearside mirror for cyclists before pulling into bus stops.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

LOW BRIDGE LOWER BRIDGE ROAD/RAYNES PARK

Under no circumstances must you enter Lower Downs Road. There is a very low bridge. 7.9 ft low bridge on Lower Bridge Road, south of Worple Road.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | WORPLE ROAD

High volume of school children at bus stops during start/finish of schools. Risk of surge forcing children into road. Check nearside for latecomers before pulling away. Check nearside mirror for cyclists before pulling into bus stops.

BUS STAND | WORPLE ROAD/FRANCIS GROVE

Bus stand for 3 buses prior to bus stop. Proceed with caution when passing bus stand and look out for pedestrians trying to cross between buses parked on the stand. Do not allow passengers to enter/disembark until on the stop.

TIGHT RIGHT TURN | WORPLE ROAD/WIMBLEDON HILL

Tight right turn due to angle of traffic island. Possible risk of collision from rear of bus whilst turning. Try to straddle both lanes at this junction prior to turning right and regularly check your nearside mirror.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | WORPLE ROAD/WIMBLEDON HILL

Tight left turn onto Worple Road. Steel bell sited on corner by Ely's store. Take this left turn wide, ensuring no passing traffic on the nearside also ensuring clearance of bell.

LANE CHANGES | WIMBLEDON BRIDGE

Lane changes from two into one. Vehicles change lanes without indicating. Check both mirrors on approach for vehicles under/overtaking.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | CENTRE COURT

High volume of pedestrian activity during peak times. This includes school children and the likelihood of surge forcing pedestrians onto road. Approach these bus stops with caution and very slow speed.

20 MPH ZONE | CENTRE COURT

Multiple routes serving this stop. When departing stop, having to cross one lane of traffic. Adhere to 20 MPH speed limit. Care and caution when crossing lane for vehicles overtaking to turn left onto Queens Road.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PEDESTRIANS CROSSING | SIR CYRIL BLACK WAY

Pedestrians crossing between bus lanes in station. Enter bus station with extreme caution looking out for pedestrians crossing.

VERY SHARP BEND | THE BROADWAY/MERTON ROAD

Approach bend and zebra crossing at slow speed. Crossing - slippery when wet.

TURNING RIGHT | SOUTH WIMBLEDON STATION

Need to cross two lanes of traffic to turn right, After serving the stop at South Wimbledon Stn, ensure your exit is clear of traffic before manoeuvring across two lanes of traffic. Take care and caution when turning right into Merton Road.

TWO LANES | MERTON HIGH ST/HAYDONS ROAD

Two lanes of traffic. Offside straight ahead, Nearside left turn Beware of nearside traffic undertaking to go straight ahead at this junction.

CYCLISTS | COLLIERS WOOD STATION

Cycle lane merges into carriageway. Cyclists join carriageway from nearside.

CYCLE SUPER HIGHWAY CS7 | COLLIERS WOOD

Two lanes into one. Beware of vehicles trying to overtake as two lanes merge into one. Beware of cyclists on the nearside using the super cycle highway.

YELLOW BOX JUNCTION TOOTING HIGH ST/BROADWAY

Traffic light camera and yellow box junction. Always obey the traffic signals and do not enter the box junction unless your exit is clear.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | TOOTING BROADWAY

Vehicles changing lanes without indicating. Be vigilant for pedestrians crossing without looking or on your green light. Also be vigilant for vehicles changing or cutting into your lane.

BUS STAND | LONGMEAD ROAD

Parked buses and pedestrian activity. Risk of collision. Proceed with extreme care and caution when entering, manoeuvring and exiting this bus stand.

CODE RED EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
