Changeovers will take place on High Street [Sutton] at BUS STOP A (Sutton Green) towards Wallington and BUS STOP B (Sutton Green) towards Worcester Park. Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason. LEADER LEADER

Route 151 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

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
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

- At double mini roundabout, take 1st exit onto Priory Road
- At junction, turn right onto Malden Road A2043
- Follow line of route to Worcester Park Station

 2100 and 0700. Do not use Church Hill Road or Priory Road during these times.

FROM WORCESTER PARK STATION

Towards Wallington. Depart to Worcester Park Station Forecourt. Pick up on Worcester Park Station Forecourt at BUS STOP A.

Public stand for one bus on station forecourt. Blind display: WORCESTER PARK.



NORTH CHEAM CURTAILMENT POINT



From Wallington. Proceed from Malden Road via London Road, Senhouse Road and Church Hill Road to stand.

Set down on Malden Road at **BUS STOP G**.

Towards Wallington. Depart via Church Hill Road to Malden Road. Pick up on Malden Road at BUS STOP J.

Public stand for one bus on south side of Church Hill Road. **Blind display:** NORTH CHEAM.



CHEAMCURTAILMENT POINT

WARNING LOW BRIDGE NEAR THIS CURTAILMENT

From Wallington. Proceed from Cheam Road via Cheam High Street, Station Way, Kingsway Road and Anne Boleyn's Walk to stand. Set down on Cheam Road at BUS STOP J.

Towards Wallington. Depart via Anne Boleyn's Walk, Ewell Road and Cheam High Street to Cheam Road. Pick up on Cheam Road at **BUS STOP H**.

Public stand for two buses on west side of Anne Boleyn's Walk. Blind display: CHEAM.




SUTTONCURTAILMENT POINT

From Wallington. Proceed from Throwley Way via Carshalton Road, Chalk Pit Way and Sutton Court Road to stand. Set down on Throwley Way at <u>BUS STOP K</u>.

Towards Wallington. Depart via Sutton Court Road, Grove Road, Sutton Park Rd and Cheam Rd to St Nicholas Way. Pick up on St Nicholas Way at *BUS STOP V*.

Public stand for one bus on south side of Sutton Court Rd, commencing west of southern section of Sutton Ct Rd slip road. **Blind display:** SUTTON TOWN CTR.





Towards Worcester Park. Depart via Sutton Bus Garage and Bushey Road (east arm) to Sutton High Street. Pick up on Sutton High Street at *BUS STOP B*.

Private stand in Sutton Bus Garage. Blind display: SUTTON, BUSHEY ROAD.


From Worcester Park. Proceed from Rose Hill, Rose Hill Roundabout, Green Lane, U-turn through central reservation at Canterbury Road and Green Lane to stand. Set down on Rose Hill, at <u>BUS STOP</u> RS.

Towards Worcester Park. Depart via Green Lane and Rose Hill Roundabout to Rose Hill. Pick up on Rose Hill at **BUS STOP RP**.

From Wallington. Proceed from Wrythe Lane via Rose Hill Roundabout, Green Lane, U-turn through central reservation at Canterbury Road and Green Lane to stand. Set down on Wrythe Lane at **BUS STOP RL**.

Towards Wallington. Depart via Green Lane and Rose Hill Roundabout to Wrythe Lane. Pick up on Wrythe Lane at **BUS STOP RK**.

Public stand for one bus at bus stop point letter RD on east side of Green Lane, outside Methodist Central Hall. Blind display: ST HELIER, ROSE HILL.



CARSHALTON CURTAILMENT POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Worcester Park. Proceed from Green Wrythe Lane via Wrythe Green Road and West Street to stand. Set down on Green Wrythe Lane at **BUS STOP H**.

Towards Worcester Park. Depart via West Street, Wrythe Lane and Wrythe Green Road to Green Wrythe Lane. Pick up on Green Wrythe Ln at *BUS STOP E*.

Public off side stand for one bus on west side of West Street. **Blind display:** WRYTHE GREEN.



HACKBRIDGE CURTAILMENT POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Worcester Park. Proceed from Hackbridge Road via London Road, Longfield Avenue and Elm Road to stand. Set down on Hackbridge Road at *BUS STOP A*.

Towards Worcester Park. Depart via Elm Road to Hackbridge Road. Pick up on Hackbridge Road at **BUS STOP H**.

From Wallington. Proceed from London Road via Longfield Avenue and Elm Road to stand. Set down on London Road at **BUS STOP B**.

Towards Worcester Park. Depart via Elm Road and Hackbridge Road to London Road. Pick up on London Road at BUS STOP D.

Public stand for three buses on east side of Elm Road. **Blind display:** HACKBRIDGE.


CURTAILMENT POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Worcester Park. Proceed from Manor Road via Railway Approach and Railway Approach Turning Circle to stand. Set down on Manor Road at *BUS STOP A*.

Towards Worcester Park. Depart to Railway Approach Turning Circle. Pick up on Railway Approach Turning Circle at *BUS STOP B*.

Private stand for one bus on west side of BR station forecourt. Blind display: WALLINGTON.



WALLINGTON TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Worcester Park. Proceed from Shotfield direct to stand. Set down on Shotfield at **BUS STOP F.**

Towards Worcester Park. Depart to Shotfield. Pick up on Shotfield at *BUS STOP F*.

Public stand for two buses on east side of Shotfield. **Blind display:** *WALLINGTON*.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

TIGHT LEFT TURN | WALLINGTON SHOTFIELD

When turning left on departure from Shotfield, proceed with caution.

PARKED VEHICLES | WALLINGTON STATION

Parking on station forecourt. Be aware of pedestrians and vehicles dropping off.

PARKED VEHICLES | MANOR ROAD

Be aware of vehicles parking on both sides of the road and look out for oncoming vehicles.

ROAD NARROWS | MANOR ROAD NORTH

Road narrows down to one lane. Proceed with caution.

LOW TREES | ELM ROAD

When curtailed, beware of low hanging trees on the offside as you turn onto Elm Road and on the nearside, beside the bus stand.

ROUNDABOUT | HACKBRIDGE CORNER

New roundabout, Proceed onto roundabout with caution.

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING | HACKBRIDGE CORNER

Unmarked courtesy pedestrian crossing. Approach with caution. Look out for pedestrians intending to use the crossing.

PARKED VEHICLES | HACKBRIDGE ROAD

Be aware of vehicles parking on both sides of the road and look out for oncoming vehicles.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | GREEN WRYTHE LANE

Calming measures, low trees. Proceed with caution. Be aware of parking at the bus stops near to the junction with Wrythe Green Road.

20 MPH ZONE | THORNTON ROAD

Collision possibility. Ensure that there is enough road space to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles. Be aware of 20 mph speed limit along the whole length of the road.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

RISK OF COLLISION | ROSE HILL ROUNDABOUT

Collision possibility. Roundabout is controlled by traffic signals. Care for other motorists crossing lanes.

RISK OF COLLISION | HIGH STREET / ANGEL HILL

Collision possibility. At the traffic lights, buses travel from the nearside then veer over to the right to go under the footbridge – be aware of traffic on the offside lane going straight ahead.

MERGING TRAFFIC | HIGH STREET / MARSHALL'S ROAD

Traffic merging. Proceed with caution and be aware that traffic merges from the offside and nearside.

OFFSIDE BUS LANE | THROWLEY WAY

Traffic turning right across bus lane. Drive slowly and be aware of the possibility of other vehicles turning right across the bus lane to enter side roads, especially at the junction with Benhill Avenue and also Manor Place.

NARROW LANES | SUTTON COURT ROAD / GROVE ROAD

Heavy pedestrian movements. Drive very carefully at this location and be aware of pedestrians crossing the road or standing near or on the edge of the kerb.

MERGING TRAFFIC | GROVE ROAD SUTTON POST OFFFICE

Traffic merging from offside. Care should be taken when crossing lanes from the bus stop as traffic departing Morrison's merges from the offside.

NARROW LANES | HIGH STREET / THE BROADWAY

To turn right at this location, you need to take the narrow offside lane. Be aware of traffic on your nearside and traffic approaching in the other direction when adopting this position.

13'6" LOW BRIDGE | STATION ROAD OFF LINE OF ROUTE

13'6" arched railway bridge. Double deck buses must not be driven under this bridge (off line of route).

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PARKED VEHICLES | ANNE BOLEYN'S WALK

Curtailments only. Parked vehicles, trees on the roadside. Care should be taken to avoid collision with overhanging branches. Ensure that there is enough road space to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles.

BUS STOP | LONDON ROAD / CHEAM COMMON ROAD

Bus stop 8354 is hard to access. After entering Cheam Common Road towards Kingston, the first bus stop is hard to access due to parked vehicles on approach. Take great care to position bus by kerb line – this may involve stopping beyond the bus stop flag. When attaining this position, take great care not to sweep the kerb by the bus stop as some minor accidents have occurred in this way at this location.

PARKED VEHICLES | SENHOUSE ROAD CURTAILMENTS ONLY

Parking on the roadside. Ensure that there is enough road space to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles.

BUS STOP | CENTRAL ROAD / LONGFELLOW ROAD

Lay-by bus stop 26959 hard to access. Towards Kingston this busy lay-by stop has limited access and is shared with car parking. There is only room for one bus. Take great care when boarding and alighting passengers as it can be impossible to get close to the kerb here at times. If car parking overflows into the bus stop area, please use a Code Blue to inform CentreComm.

TIGHT LEFT TURN | WORCESTER PARK STATION

Tight left turn onto Central Road when departing. When turning left from Worcester Park Station proceed with caution. Beware of pedestrians walking across the station forecourt and vehicles dropping off people.

PARKED VEHICLES | COLLINGWOOD ROAD LIGHT RUN

Parked vehicles on both sides. Parked vehicles close to traffic islands. Speed cushions. Look out for oncoming vehicles and ensure there is enough road space to proceed. Drive over speed tables slowly and with care to avoid damage to vehicle.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VARIOUS | PRIORY RD / CHURCH HILL RD LIGHT RUN

Ensure that there is enough road space to proceed and look out for oncoming vehicles. Drive over speed humps and cushions slowly and with care to avoid damage to vehicle. Care should be taken to avoid collision with overhanging branches. Tree growth can reduce the effect of street lighting in summer so take extra care at night. Do not use Church Hill Road or Priory Road between 2100 and 0700 on any day. Use Malden Road, The Broadway, High Street [Cheam] and St Dunstan's Hill instead. Low bridge near High Street.

RIGHT TURN | PRIORY RD / MALDEN ROAD LIGHT RUN

Care should be taken to look out for oncoming traffic on Malden Road – ensure it is safe to proceed before performing right turn manoeuvre. **Do not use**Priory Road between 2100 and 0700 on any day. Use Malden Road, The Broadway, High Street [Cheam] and St Dunstan's Hill instead. Low bridge near High Street.

TIGHT AND BLIND BEND | CARSHALTON PONDS LIGHT RUN

Tight and blind bend on Carshalton Road. Vehicles approaching in middle of road. Approach this bend at slow speed and with great care in both directions.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | SCHOOLS EN ROUTE

St Dunstan's Cheam Primary School, Cheam Park Farm Primary Academy, Nonsuch High School for Girls, Leapfrog Day Nursery, Hackbridge Primary School. Be aware of pupils surging into the road space when arriving at bus stops at school closing times.

If you urgently need to use the following interim facility, please inform iBus first.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
