

CHANGEOVER | STOCKWELL ROAD

Towards Elephant & Castle on Stockwell Road at <u>BUS STOP R</u> (Stockwell Gardens). Towards Tooting Broadway on Stockwell Road at <u>BUS STOP X</u> (Stockwell Gardens). Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.







Route 333 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

Public stand for ten buses on the north side of Stockwell Park Walk. **Blind display:** *BRIXTON*.



From Elephant & Castle. Proceed from Brixton Road, Effra Road to stand. Set down on Brixton Road at *BUS STOP* **S**.

Towards Elephant & Castle. Depart via Effra Road, St Matthew's Road to Brixton Hill. Pick up on Brixton Hill at <u>BUS STOP P</u>.

Public stand for 3 buses on west side (offside) of Effra Road. Available Mondays to Fridays before 1600 only and all day Saturdays and Sundays. At other times use Brixton, Lambeth Town Hall (Brixton Hill) stand.

Blind display: BRIXTON.





From Elephant & Castle. Proceed from Brixton Hill, Streatham Hill, Streatham Place, Atkins Road to stand.
Set down on Brixton Road at BUS STOP 5.

Towards Elephant & Castle. Depart via Atkins Road, Poynders Road, Atkins Road, Streatham Place to Brixton Hill. Pick up on Brixton Hill at BUS STOP P.

Offside public stand on the north side of Atkins Road immediately west of the junction with Kings Avenue. **Blind display:** BRIXTON HILL, CHRISTCHURCH ROAD.





Public stand for one bus on west side of Streatham Hill, opposite Wavertree Road. **Blind display:** *BRIXTON*.





Turning point only - buses must not stand. **Blind display:** *BRIXTON*.



From Elephant & Castle. Proceed from Mitcham Road, Longmead Road to stand. Set down on Mitcham Road at **BUS STOP R**.

Towards Elephant & Castle. Depart via Longmead Road to Mitcham Road. Pick up on Mitcham Road at *BUS STOP C*.

Public stand for five buses in Longmead Road in three parts. **Blind display:** TOOTING BROADWAY.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VARIOUS HAZARDS | SOUTHWARK BRIDGE ROAD

Road traffic islands and low trees. 20 mph. Position bus correctly so as not to damage tyres on islands and use centre of road to avoid low trees. Take care when pulling out from bus stand and look out for trunk of tree close to kerb. Do not park on opposite carriageway.

BUSY JUNCTION | ELEPHANT & CASTLE ROUNDABOUT

Very busy major road junction. Moving off from Tabernacle bus stop. Ensure road is clear on offside before pulling out of the Tabernacle bus stop to gain access to correct lane.

BUSY BUS STOPS | ELEPHANT & CASTLE

Heavy use of all bus stops with pedestrians sometimes standing in the road way and parked buses. Fast moving offside traffic when pulling away from bus stops. 20 mph. Keep a good look out for passengers walking in roadway and be prepared to apply brakes quickly if necessary. When pulling away, good use of mirrors essential in order to gain access to correct lane.

ROAD NARROWS KENNINGTON LANE

At end of bus lane northbound, road narrows at traffic lights. Watch for motorists on offside of bus at traffic lights and check mirrors before moving off to avoid a collision.

PROTRUDING TREES KENNINGTON PARK ROAD

Bus lanes in both directions. Trees standing out near kerb in a southbound direction. Watch motorists using bus lanes out of hours and parking. Keep the bus away from the kerb area southbound to avoid contact with the trees.

BUSY JUNCTION KENNINGTON PARK ROAD

Junction with Brixton Road. Getting in the wrong lane will cause problems with traffic on both sides of the bus. 20 mph. In both directions, pullover to the offside lane to position yourself for the correct offside lane at the junction with Kennington Park Road.

BUS STOP | CLAPHAM ROAD SOUTHBOUND

Pulling away from bus stop at tube station. Make good use of mirrors before pulling out into main traffic flow prior to entry to bus lane.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

CS7 | STOCKWELL TO ELEPHANT & CASTLE

20 mph. Beware of cyclists using CS7 and be prepared to allow room to overtake. Ensure it is clear on offside and nearside when serving bus stops.

CYCLISTS | STOCKWELL WAR MEMORIAL CLAPHAM ROAD

(Northbound). Cyclists 20 mph. Crossing junction with South Lambeth Road beware of cyclists on nearside.

PEDESTRIANS | STOCKWELL ROAD / CLAPHAM ROAD

Many traffic movements both near and offside. Busy pedestrian movements at all sets of traffic lights. Good use of mirrors and focus on traffic ahead of you and keep an eye on traffic light phasing.

SCHOOL CHILDREN STOCKWELL PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

Volume of school children/students outside at school times. 20 mph. Watch for pedestrians who may spill into the roadway – slow down.

CONTRAFLOW BUS LANE | STOCKWELL ROAD

Contraflow bus lane between Stockwell Park Road and Brixton Road. 20 mph. Use headlights and watch for pedestrians crossing the road at any point.

PARKED VEHICLES | STOCKWELL ROAD

Junction with Stockwell Park Road (northbound). Rear overhang from buses turning right at junction. Take extra care if next to a bus in the offside lane that is turning right.

PEDESTRIANS | STOCKWELL ROAD O2 ACADEMY

Very busy pedestrian area when concerts are being held. Box junction. 20 mph. Always use head lights and make sure you observe pedestrians and their actions. Take care not to block box junction when turning right from Stockwell Road onto Brixton Road.

PARKED VEHICLES | BRIXTON SHOPPING CENTRE

Many pedestrian movements and busy bus stops in bus lanes. Be alert for any unusual pedestrian movement from between park vehicles, and passengers standing in the roadway at bus stops.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

ELECTRIC NIGHTCLUB | BRIXTON HILL

Car parking at shops northbound near junction with Christchurch Road. Bus lanes both sides of the road with out of hours parking. On Sunday's, considerable parking near Brixton Water Lane for churches. Near the one-way system, the Fridge and the Mass Bar night clubs attract many customers who cross the road between the Fridge and St Matthews Church. Many old trees with heavy growth along line of route 20 mph. Read the road ahead in this area before passing parked vehicles. Watch out for motorists changing lanes and using the bus lanes out of hours. Look for pedestrian movements in the areas of the night clubs where people cross the road at any point. Position bus away from kerb unless serving a bus stop to avoid damage to bus by trees.

BUS MOVEMENTS | BRIXTON BUS GARAGE

Buses waiting or turning to enter bus garage. Watch for buses moving slowly across lanes of traffic to gain entry and give way.

CYCLISTS | STREATHAM HILL TELFORD AVE

Between Telford Avenue and Streatham Hill Station. Busy area for traffic, parked cars and pedestrians especially at weekends. Drive with extreme caution bearing in mind that pedestrians dash across the road at any point in this area form behind parked vehicles.

DANGER OF COLLISION | STREATHAM HIGH ROAD

Streatham Hill and Streatham High Road. Heavy traffic at times, parked delivery vehicles and high pedestrian movements at unauthorised places along the road. At various points along this stretch of road, the road reduces from two lanes to one lane. This is especially difficult near the Odeon southbound, where there is also a right hand turn onto Becmead Avenue from the outside lane. Be observant. Use mirrors when overtaking parked vehicles and watch for pedestrians emerging from behind parked cars to cross the roads. Drive carefully and use mirrors well where the road reduces from two to one lane.

PARKED VEHICLES | STREATHAM HIGH ROAD

20 mph. Bus lanes in operation with parking bays at night. Busy pedestrian movements. Look for motorists who have driven across bus lane markings and narrowed lanes. At night check for parked cars restricting through passage and indicate clearly to move out of bus lane. Keep a look out for pedestrians crossing the road,

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

SOUTHBOUND BUS STOP | MITCHAM LANE

Pulling away from southbound stop at St Leonard's Church. Make sure good use is made of offside mirror before pulling into main traffic thoroughfare.

ACCIDENT HOTSPOT | MITCHAM LANE / AMBLESIDE AVE

Mitcham Lane junction with Ambleside Avenue. **Accident hotspot.** Watch for traffic that can jump the lights at times.

PARKED CARS MITCHAM LANE/THRALE ROAD

Busy area for parked cars and pedestrians. Traffic calming measures in place - platforms. Take care when passing parked cars and keep an eye for pedestrians crossing at any point. Reduce speed to negotiate platforms and avoid damaging bus suspension.

TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES | SOUTHCROFT ROAD

20 mph. Traffic calming measures to negotiate – chicanes. Many pedestrian movements crossing the road at any point. Keep speed under control and position bus carefully when negotiating chicanes. Read the road ahead and be mindful of sudden pedestrian movements and be prepared to stop quickly.

USE CORRECT LANE | AMEN CORNER

Amen Corner, junction with Mitcham Road and Southcroft Road (southbound). Junction with two directional lanes. Make sure you select the nearside lane to proceed into Southcroft Road.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | MITCHAM ROAD

Mitcham Road from Amen Corner to main shopping centre. Many parked vehicles and pedestrian movements plus traffic calming platforms at lights by Mellsion Road. Difficult right hand turn into Longmead Road. Watch for pedestrians crossing the road at any points. Slow down for the platforms. After finishing service at the last stop on Mitcham Road, check mirrors thoroughly before pulling out across lanes of traffic to pull across into Longmead Road. Note: This is a very busy crossing point so watch for all pedestrians.

PEDESTRIANS LONGMEAD ROAD BUS STAND

Pedestrians in the roadway and on the bus stand in the centre of the road. This bus stand is congested most of the day. Take every care to look for pedestrians in the area as you turn the bus round.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.



Call your garage for non-emergency, mechanical defects, help or advice



Call CentreComm for non-emergency, incident reporting or diversions
