

CHANGEOVER | BECKTON BUS STATION

Changeovers will take place at Beckton bus station.

Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.







Route 376 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.





IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS **IMMEDIATELY** IF RUNNING LIGHT

TO EAST HAM NEWHAM TOWN HALL

- From Silvertown garage, turn right onto Factory Road
- At junction, turn right onto Albert Road
- At traffic light, continue ahead onto Woolwich Manor Way
- Continue ahead onto Steve Redgrave Bridge
- Continue ahead onto Woolwich Manor Way
- At Gallions Reach roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Woolwich Manor Way A117
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Woolwich Manor Way
- At 2nd roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Woolwich Manor Way
- At 3rd roundabout, take 3rd exit onto Woolwich Manor Way (past Premier Inn)


SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Beckton Bus Station. Proceed from High Street South via Nelson Street and Wellington Road to stand. Set down on High Street South at **BUS STOP V**.

Towards Beckton Bus Station. Depart via Wellington Road to Barking Road. Pick up on Barking Road at *BUS STOP W*.

 $Public\ stand\ for\ four\ buses\ on\ west\ side\ of\ Wellington\ Road.$

Blind display: EAST HAM, NEWHAM TOWN HALL.



EAST HAM CURTAILMENT POINT

PLEASE CHECK TRIP NUMBER ON ETM BEFORE DEPARTING

From Beckton Bus Station. Proceed from Plashet Grove via High Street North and Wordsworth Avenue to stand. Set down on Plashet Grove South at **BUS STOP E**.

Towards Beckton Bus Station. Depart via Wordsworth Avenue and Woodhouse Grove to Plashet Grove. Pick up on Plashet Grove at *BUS STOP M*.

Public stand for two buses on south side of Wordsworth Avenue. No more than 2 buses on Route 376 should be scheduled to stand at any one time. **Blind display:** *EAST HAM, PLASHET GROVE.*



UPTON PARKCURTAILMENT POINT

PLEASE CHECK **TRIP NUMBER** ON ETM BEFORE DEPARTING

From Beckton Bus Station. Proceed from Green Street via Neville Road and Stukeley Road to stand. Set down on Green St at *BUS STOP D*.

Towards Beckton Bus Station. Depart via Stukeley Road and Plashet Road to Green Street. Pick up on Green Street at BUS STOP B.

Public stand for one bus on the east side of Stukeley Road. **Blind display:** *UPTON PARK STATION*.



UPTON PARKCURTAILMENT POINT

PLEASE BE AWARE OF PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS

From Beckton Bus Station. Proceed from Boundary Road via Claughton Road to stand. Set down on Boundary Road at *BUS STOP P*.

Towards Beckton Bus Station. Depart via Claughton Road, Barking Road and Central Park Road to Boundary Road.

Pick up on Boundary Road at BUS STOP BENSON AVENUE.

From East Ham. Proceed from Green Street via Central Park Road, Boundary Road and Claughton Road to stand. Set down in Green Street at **BUS STOP F.**

Towards East Ham. Depart via Claughton Road and Barking Road to Green Street. Pick up on Green Street at *BUS STOP G*.

Public stand on west side of Claughton Road. Blind display: UPTON PARK, BOLEYN.



NEWHAMCURTAILMENT POINT

PLEASE CHECK TRIP NUMBER ON ETM BEFORE DEPARTING

From Beckton Bus Station. Proceed from Private Road In Newham General Hospital Grounds via Glen Road to stand.

Set down on Glen Road at BUS STOP HG.

Towards Beckton Bus Station. Depart via Glen Road, Boundary Lane and Glen Road to Private Road in Newham General Hospital Grounds. Pick up on Glen Road at *BUS STOP HA*.

Private stand for 3 buses on north side of Glen Road in grounds of Newham General Hospital. **Blind display:** NEWHAM HOSPITAL.



CYPRUSCURTAILMENT POINT

PLEASE CHECK TRIP NUMBER ON ETM BEFORE DEPARTING

From East Ham. Proceed from Strait Road via East Ham Manor Way to stand. Set down in Strait Road at *BUS STOP* **5**.

Towards East Ham. Depart via East Ham Manor Way, Woolwich Manor Way and East Ham Manor Way to Strait Road. Pick up on Strait Road at *BUS STOP R*.

Public stand for three buses on west side of East Ham Manor Way. **Blind display:** CYPRUS.



WINSOR PARK ESTATE

TURNING POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.


From East Ham. Proceed from Woolwich Manor Way via Horse Leaze and Covelees Wall.

Set down on Woolwich Manor Way at BUS STOP F.

Towards East Ham. Depart to Warwall. Pick up on Warwall at *BUS STOP WINSOR PARK ESTATE*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand.

Blind display: WINSOR PARK


TERMINUS POINT

PLEASE CHECK TRIP NUMBER ON ETM BEFORE DEPARTING

From East Ham. Proceed from Beckton Bus Station direct to stand. Set down on Beckton Bus Station at BUS STOP A.

Towards East Ham. Depart to Beckton Bus Station. Pick up on Beckton Bus Station at *BUS STOP B*.

Private stand for four buses on Routes 366 and 376 in 2 portions on south side of bus station on west side of Woolwich Manor Way. **Blind display: BECKTON STATION.**



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

SEE RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

PARKED VEHICLES | EAST HAM, NELSON ROAD

Parked vehicles on both sides of the road. Drivers to take care and caution and use appropriate speed.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA TOWN HALL BARKING ROAD

Very busy area with pedestrians crossing between parked vehicles often without looking. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution and to report any near misses.

BUSY BUS STOPS | HIGH STREET NORTH

Drivers are required to wait for intending passengers. When closing the doors, ensure it is clear.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | HIGH STREET NORTH

Very busy area with pedestrians crossing between parked vehicles often without looking. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution and to report any near misses.

VERY NARROW ROAD | PLASHET GROVE EAST HAM

Very narrow road with cars often parked on either side. Risk of collision with oncoming vehicles if driver fails to plan ahead. Additionally, there is a primary school, mosque and registry office. Drivers advised to take care and caution and are required to plan ahead. Only proceed if it is safe to do so.

MINI ROUNDABOUTS | PLASHET GROVE EAST HAM

Mini roundabouts may lead to discomfort, injury or damage to bus if taken at speed. Drivers advised to reduce speed and to exercise care when passing.

PEDESTRIAN AREA | PLASHET GROVE UPTON PARK

Very busy area with pedestrians crossing between parked vehicles often without looking. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution and to report any near misses.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | GREEN STREET

Very busy area with pedestrians crossing between parked vehicles often without looking. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution and to report any near misses.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

SEE RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VERY NARROW ROAD | BOUNDARY ROAD

Very narrow road with cars often parked on either side. Risk of collision with oncoming vehicles if driver fails to plan ahead. Additionally, there is a primary school, mosque and registry office. Drivers advised to take care and caution and are required to plan ahead. Only proceed if it is safe to do so.

BARRIER | NEWHAM GENERAL HOSPITAL/GLEN ROAD

No through road for general traffic, only London Buses. Nearside blocked by barrier which is not in use. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution when passing the barriers on the offside lane. Be aware of other vehicles.

POTHOLES | GLEN ROAD

Potholes may lead to discomfort, injury or damage to bus if taken at speed. Drivers advised to reduce speed and to exercise care and caution when passing.

SHARP LEFT TURN | PRINCE REGENT LANE/GLEN ROAD

Sharp left turn out of Glen Road onto Prince Regent Lane. Risk of collision/damage if bus is not positioned correctly. Drivers advised to exercise caution when passing and to keep checking mirrors.

BUSY BUS STOPS | PRINCE REGENT LANE

Drivers are required to wait for intending passengers. When closing the doors, ensure it is clear.

UNEVEN ROAD SURFACE | STANSFIELD ROAD

Uneven road surface may lead to discomfort, injury to passengers or damage to bus if taken at speed. London City Farm in the area. Drivers advised to plan ahead and approach with caution. Drivers must take extra care and allow plenty of room when passing and do not accelerate too fast when passing horses.

RISK OF COLLISION | STRAIT ROAD

Uneven road surface may lead to discomfort, injury to passengers or damage to bus if taken at speed. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution when passing.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

SEE RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

TIGHT RIGHT TURN | WINSOR PARK ESTATE

Very narrow road with sharp right turns and blind bends. Risk of collision if driver fails to read the road ahead. Approach junctions and bend with caution. Speed humps have been added. Drivers advised to exercise care and caution when turning and approaching bends and give way when possible. Drivers must adhere to the speed limit.

BUSY BUS STOPS | BECKTON BUS STATION

Drivers are required to wait for intending passengers. When closing the doors, ensure it is clear.

BUSY BUS STOPS | BECKTON BUS STATION

Offside parking on stand. Risk of bus passing if you step off the bus or if you drive past a bus driver when they are stepping off. Approach parked buses with caution and look before stepping off the bus.

FACILITIES | THROUGHOUT THE ROUTE

• **Beckton Bus Station.** TfL facilities available in the bus station. If you urgently need to use a facility, please inform iBus immediately.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. You will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.

Call CentreComm for emergency services, passenger injury or assault
