



THINGS TO REMEMBER

MAKE NOTES ALONG THE WAY!

Changeovers will take place on New Cross Road outside bus garage.

Always communicate in advance with iBus if you are late for any reason.





Route 436 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.


From Battersea Park. Proceed from New Cross Road via Sainsbury's Access Road, New Cross Road, Pepys Road and New Cross Bus Garage to stand. Set down on New Cross Road at **BUS STOP H**.

Towards Battersea Park. Depart via New Cross Bus Garage to New Cross Road. Pick up on New Cross Road at *BUS STOP K*.

From Lewisham. Proceed from New Cross Road via New Cross Bus Garage to stand. Set down on New Cross Road at *BUS STOP* **o**.

Towards Lewisham. Depart via New Cross Bus Garage to New Cross Road. Pick up on New Cross Road at *BUS STOP M*.

Private stand in New Cross Garage on south side of New Cross Road. **Blind display:** *NEW CROSS GATE*.

From Battersea Park. Proceed from Peckham High Street. Set down on Peckham High Street at *BUS STOP G*.



From Battersea Park. Proceed from Camberwell New Rd via Denmark Hill, Orpheus St, Daneville Rd, Denmark Hill, Camberwell New Rd, Camberwell Station Rd and Bus Garage. Set down on Camberwell New Road at BUS STOP H.

Towards Battersea Park. Depart via Camberwell Bus Garage to Camberwell New Road. Pick up on Camberwell New Road at *BUS STOP M*.

From Lewisham. Proceed from Camberwell New Rd via Camberwell Station Rd and Camberwell Garage to stand. Set down on Camberwell New Rd at **BUS STOP J**.

Towards Lewisham. Depart via Camberwell Garage, Camberwell New Road and Camberwell Grn (South Side) to Camberwell Church Street. Pick up on Camberwell Church Street at *BUS STOP K*. **Blind display:** *CAMBERWELL*.




TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND

From Lewisham. Proceed from Prince Of Wales Drive direct to stand. Set down on Prince Of Wales Drive at *BUS STOP P*.

Towards Lewisham. Depart from Prince Of Wales Drive direct to stand. Pick up on Battersea Park Road at *BUS STOP A*.

Public stand for 1 bus located to the west of *BUS STOP P*. **Blind display:** *BATTERSEA PARK STATION*.



FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | LEWISHAM HIGH ST

Keep headlights on and proceed with care and caution, particularly at weekends due to heavy pedestrian movement. Parked car at weekends.

LANES MERGE | LEWISHAM CLOCK TOWER BUS STOP

Three lanes become two lanes after the traffic lights. Take the middle lane and watch out for traffic pushing in from the right, onto your lane.

BLIND CORNER | EXITING STATION ROAD

Blind corner and awkwardly placed traffic light. View restricted by wall on right. Be aware of cyclists jumping the traffic lights and watch out for vehicles stopping in front of the secondary traffic lights, blocking your exit.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | STATION ROAD DLR STN

Busy pedestrian crossing. Buses on alighting stop blocking view of oncoming buses from pedestrians waiting to cross. Parked buses also block view of the crossing from approaching buses. If buses are on the alighting stop, exercise extreme caution when approaching the crossing and keep your speed right down. Never try to beat the pedestrian crossing lights. There is a cycle bay in front of the crossing. Never stop in the cycle bay. Do not use the alighting bays as a stand, they are for passengers to alight only.

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING | LEWISHAM COLLEGE

Be aware of large numbers of students at all times.

PEDESTRIANS | SHARDELOUS ROAD / LEWISHAM WAY

Junction between Shardelous Road and Lewisham Way. No pedestrian crossing at Shardelous Road. Beware of pedestrians and cyclists unaware of traffic approaching from Amersham Road.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | GOLDSMITHS COLLEGE

Be aware of large numbers of students at all times.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | VENUE NIGHTCLUB

Volume of traffic and people. Be aware of large numbers of students at all times.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST



20 MPH ZONE | NEW CROSS ROAD

Slow moving traffic. Care and caution at peak periods of time.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | NEW CROSS GATE STATION

High volume of pedestrians/cyclists. Care and caution when approaching the station. Lookout for cyclists and pedestrians.

BUSES ENTERING AND EXITING NEW CROSS GARAGE

Slow down and lookout for buses departing or entering the garage. Lookout for cyclists and pedestrians blocked by buses.

ROAD NARROWS | ERLANGER ROAD / QUEEN'S ROAD

Road narrows due to Cycle Superhighway. Be aware of cyclists at this location as the road narrows, remain behind then until it is safe to overtake.

EMERGENCY VEHICLES | NEW CROSS FIRE STATION

Give way to emergency vehicles exiting or entering the fire station.

ACCIDENT HOTSPOT | POMEROY ST / QUEEN'S ROAD

Towards New Cross. Bus lane at the lights ends and other side becomes one lane - ACCIDENT HOTSPOT with cars on offside. Check offside mirror before proceeding, for vehicles on the offside. Give a hand signal if required to hold cars back be prepared to give way.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | RYE LANE

Keep headlights on and proceed with care and caution, particularly at weekends due to heavy pedestrian movement. Look out for cyclists.

ROAD LAYOUT CHANGE | RYE LANE

New dropped kerbs and bus access only area. One-way bus only traffic and 2-way cycle traffic. Keep headlights on and proceed with care and caution, particularly at weekends due to heavy pedestrian/cycle movement.

CYCLISTS | RYE LANE

When turning right from Hanover Park onto Rye Lane, beware of cyclists jumping the red signal from the left into the pedestrian area. Before completing the right turn, make one final check for cyclists.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

BOX JUNCTION | DENMARK HILL JUNCTION

Vehicles blocking box junction and u-turns/cyclists. Watch out for cars making a u-turn to gain access to Denmark Hill (towards New Cross) and for vehicles stopping suddenly in the box junction due to heavy traffic at peak times. Be aware of cyclists.

VOLUME OF PEDESTRIANS | OVAL CRICKET / STATION

Exercise extreme caution when cricket is on due to excessive pedestrian movements by supporters going to/from the game. Normal diversion may be implemented. Please be advised.

CYCLISTS | HARLEYFORD ROAD (TWDS BATTERSEA)

Cyclists moving across heading towards the station. Be aware of cyclists changing direction.

STOP LINE | VAUXHALL BUS STATION (TWDS LEWISHAM)

Please ensure that you stop at the stop line, as vehicles approaching from the left have priority.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | VAUXHALL BUS STATION

Be aware of large volumes of pedestrians in the bus station, especially during peak times.

CHANGING LANE VAUXHALL BUS STN (TWDS LEWISHAM)

After the last bus stop on Nine Elms Lane, move over to the third lane. Care and caution as traffic may not give right of way.

20 MPH ZONE | VAUXHALL BUS STATION

Observe the speed limit at all times.

CYCLISTS | EMBASSY GARDENS (BATTERSEA)

Ongoing building works with associated vehicles and width restrictions. Care and caution. Look out for construction vehicles turning.

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

TIGHT RIGHT TURN | QUEENSTOWN ROAD

Tight right turn onto Battersea Park Road. Care and caution turning onto Battersea Park Road as it is a very sharp turn. Be aware of cyclists jumping the traffic lights.

VARIOUS DEMONSTRATIONS | KENNINGTON PARK

Various demonstrations and events in Kennington Park. Volume of vehicles and people. Follow instructions as and when notified.

INTRODUCTION OF 20 MPH ZONE | WHOLE ROUTE

Change of speed limits from 30 mph to 20 mph. Be aware of sudden changes.

CYCLISTS | CYCLE SUPERHIGHWAY

Cycle Superhighway between New Cross and Vauxhall towards Victoria in both directions and in general. Be aware of cyclists at all times. Give them enough room and expect them to the unpredictable. Never overtake on approach to bus stops or traffic signals.

SCHOOL CHILDREN | SCHOOLS EN ROUTE

Kender Primary School, Haberdashers' Aske's Hatcham College (Jerningham Road Site), Saint James Hatcham Primary School, Lucas Vale Primary School, Ashmead Primary School, Myatt Garden Primary School, St. Saviour's R.C. Primary School, Sacred Heart Catholic Secondary School and Archbishop Tenison's School Academy. Be aware of the volume of school children during school hours and term time as they may unexpectedly run out into the road.

FACILITIES | THROUGHOUT THE ROUTE

- Lewisham, Molesworth Street. TfL 24 hour facility.
- **New Cross Garage**. Private facilities in bus garage. Interim toilet facility.
- **Vauxhall Bus Station.** Interim toilet facility. You must inform iBus and passengers *If you urgently need to use the following interim facility, please inform iBus first.*

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.
