

CHANGEOVER POINT | RIVER ROAD

River Road at **bus stand in front** of **BUS STOP Q** (Waverley Gardens) towards Dagenham Dock and on River Road at **BUS STOP M** (Waverley Gardens) towards Becontree Heath. Please see map on page 23 for details.

Route EL2 is a high frequency route. Headway is a measurement of the distance or time between buses. You can tell that you are on the correct Headway by using the iBus Headway indicator in the cab.

IMPORTANT: You must keep your bus as close to the middle of the indicator as possible. Take action and drop back if you are closing in to the bus in front.

RUNNING OUT OF SERVICE

IMPORTANT LOG OFF IBUS **IMMEDIATELY** IF RUNNING LIGHT

TO DAGENHAM DOCK STATION:

- From River Road garage, turn right onto River Road
- At traffic light, turn right onto Thames Road
- At junction, turn left onto Renwick Road
- Turn right onto Choats Road
- At roundabout, take 2nd exit onto Choats Road
- At junction, turn left onto Chequers Lane
- At the end of Chequers Lane, turn right to bus stand (under overpass) to stand

FROM DAGENHAM DOCK STATION:

- At stand, exit the bus stand and turn left onto Chequers Lane
- Turn right onto Choats Road
- At roundabout, take 1st exit onto Choats Road
- At junction, turn left onto Renwick Road


TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILSTATTHE

STAND From Dagenham Dock. Proceed from Becontree Heath Bus Station direct to stand. Set down in Becontree Heath Bus Station at ALIGHTING POINT.

Towards Dagenham Dock. Depart via Becontree Heath Bus Station to Wood Lane. Pick up on Wood Lane at BUS STOP K.

Private stand for 4 buses standing abreast in marked bays in bus station on south side of Wood Lane. Blind display: BECONTREE HEATH.



From Becontree Heath. Proceed from Wood Lane via Thompson Road, Halbutt Street and Five Elms Road. Set down on Wood Lane at BUS STOP L.

Towards Becontree Heath. Depart to and pick up on Wood Lane at BUS STOP N.

From Dagenham Dock. Proceed from Wood Lane via Thompson Road, Halbutt Street and Five Elms Road. Set down on Wood Lane at **BUS STOP N**.

Towards Dagenham Dock. Depart to and pick up on Wood Lane at *BUS STOP M*Turning point only - buses must not stand. **Blind display:** *FIVE ELMS*.




BECONTREETURNING POINT

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Dagenham Dock. Proceed from Longbridge Road via Bennett's Castle Lane, Becontree Avenue, Valence Avenue and Porters Avenue. Set down on Bennett's Castle Lane at <u>BUS STOP WU</u>.

Towards Dagenham Dock. Depart to Wood Lane. Pick up on Wood Lane at *BUS STOP WS*.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: BENNETT'S CASTLE LANE.



BARKING STATION

CURTAILMENT POINT TUR

TURNING POINT ONLY. BUSES MUST NOT STAND.

From Dagenham Dock. Proceed from Longbridge Road (circumnavigate roundabout at junction with Fanshawe Avenue) direct to stand. Set down on Longbridge Road at *BUS STOP L*.

Towards Dagenham Dock. Depart via Longbridge Road to Station Parade. Pick up on Station Parade at *BUS STOP H.*

Public stand on for two buses on the south-east side of Longbridge Road. **Blind display:** *BARKING*.



BARKINGCURTAILMENT POINT

IMPORTANT PLEASE ENSURE YOU USE YOUR RIBAS KEY ON EVERY TRIP

From Becontree Heath. Proceed from Station Parade via London Road and London Road Bus Stand to stand. Set down on London Road at **BUS STOP H**.

Towards Becontree Heath. Depart via London Road Bus Stand, London Road and Station Parade to Longbridge Road. Pick up on Longbridge Road at **BUS STOP L**.

Private stand for nine buses in bus parking area on north side of London Road. **Blind display:** *BARKING*.




RIVER ROAD TURNING POINT

From Dagenham Dock. Proceed from River Road via Alfred's Way (East Ham And Barking By-Pass), Beckton Roundabout and Alfred's Way (East Ham And Barking By-Pass). Set down on River Road at BUS STOP M.

Towards Dagenham Dock. Depart to River Road.

Pick up on River Road at **BUS STOP Q**.

Turning point only - buses must not stand. Blind display: RIVER ROAD, WAVERLEY GARDENS.



BARKING RIVERSIDE

CURTAILMENT POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILST AT THE STAND


From Becontree Heath. Proceed from Choats Road via Northgate Road and Northgate Road Lay-By to stand.

Set down on Choats Road at BUS STOP NORTHGATE ROAD.

Towards Becontree Heath. Depart via Northgate Road to Choats Road. Pick up on Choats Road at *BUS STOP NORTHGATE ROAD*.

Private stand for two buses in lay-by adjacent to Northgate Road, approximately 150m south of junction with Choats Road.

Blind display: BARKING RIVERSIDE, NORTHGATE ROAD.




DAGENHAM DOCK TERMINUS POINT

SWITCH THE ENGINE OFF WHILSTATTHE STAND

From Becontree Heath. Proceed from Dagenham Dock Bus Station direct to stand. Set down in Dagenham Dock Bus Station at BUS STOP EL.

Towards Becontree Heath. Depart to Dagenham Dock Bus Station. Pick up on Dagenham Dock Bus Station at BUS STOP EL.

Private stand on east side of Chequers Lane underneath A13 viaduct. Blind display: DAGENHAM DOCK.



LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

OFFSIDE PARKING | BECONTREE BUS STAND

Offside parking may be needed if bus stand is busy. Risk of stepping off bus into path of other buses. 10 mph speed limit. Drivers advised to ensure they wear a hi-vis at all times in the bus station and look before exiting the bus.

CHECK MIRRORS | WOOD LANE BECONTREE LEISURE CTR

Often people running for the bus especially at school finish times. Risk of collision with pedestrians if mirrors are not constantly checked before pulling away. Full mirror checks must be completed before moving off, be prepared to stop suddenly should pedestrians, particularly children run to catch the bus.

LOW TREES | LONGBRIDGE ROAD

Drivers advised not to drive in the marked parking bays, they should take the live traffic lane, this will avoid collisions with the trees. TfL/Council to be informed of any overhanging branches.

BUSY PEDESTRIAN AREA | BARKING STATION

Very busy station, often people running for the bus or for the trains. Risk of collison with pedestrians. Many buses in the area on both sides of the road reducing passing space. Full mirror checks MUST be completed before moving off, be prepared to stop suddenly should pedestrians run into the road. Time and patience needed as passing other vehicles to avoid mirror collisions.

BUSY SHOPPING AREA | VICARAGE FIELDS CENTRE

20 mph zone, very busy pedestrian shopping area. Market on the bend as the bus turns onto Ripple Road. Extreme care and caution. 20 mph, but it is advisable to use a lower speed due to the high volume of pedestrians in this area. Drivers be prepared to use horn to alert pedestrians to your presence.

LANE DISCIPLINE | RIPPLE ROAD / MOVERS LANE

Tight turn onto Movers Lane from Ripple Road. Drivers advised to straddleboth lanes on approach and watch for cyclists coming down on your inside as you take it wide. Remember bus is 11.2m long.

ZEBRA CROSSING | MOVERS LANE

Park gates exit straight onto the zebra crossing. Extreme caution needed on approach to the crossing, reduce speed and check crossing in both directions.

LOCAL HAZARDS & POINTS TO NOTE

FULL RISK ASSESSMENT VIEWABLE UPON REQUEST

VERY BUSY JUNCTION | RIVER ROAD A13 JUNCTION

Busy junction lanes merge into one lane (towards Becontree), 2 towards Dagenham Dock, vehicles making illegal U-turns. Extra care and caution to be taken, check mirrors regularly.

LANE DISCIPLINE | RIVER ROAD

2 lanes into 1, vehicles trying to merge into River Road off the A13. Extra care and caution to be taken, check mirrors regularly.

CHANGEOVER POINT | RIVER ROAD / WAVERLEY GARDENS

Changeover point towards Becontree, end of bus lane. Good o/s mirror checks needed when leaving this stop, vehicles often cut in at the last minute to take the slip road onto the A13.

VARIOUS HAZARDS | BASTABLE AVENUE

Overhanging trees, speed humps, school, shopping area and width restriction. High pedestrian movement during school times (am/pm). Extra care & caution required. Drivers to use appropriate speed and to regularly check mirrors.

BUS LANE CHOATS ROAD

Bus lane in middle of road with width restrictions either side for cars to pass through. Drivers advised to exercise caution. Extra caution to be taken.

BUS LANE | THAMES VIEW HEALTH CENTRE

Buses only section of the road, zebra crossing, local shops, health centre. Be aware of cars changing direction at the last moment to avoid buses only area. Extreme caution needed on approach to the zebra crossing, high bushes block your full view, heavy pedestrian area due to shops and health centre.

POT HOLES | CHOATS ROAD / CHEQUERS LANE

Potholes in road and risk of discomfort or damage if taken at speed. Lorries exiting from Breach Lane pulling out with stopping/looking. Drivers advised to reduce speed and use care and caution. Be prepared to stop suddenly for large vehicles who are not taking care when pulling out of their yard.

OFFSIDE PARKING | DAGENHAM DOCK BUS STAND

Offside parking may be needed if bus stand is busy. Risk of stepping off bus into path of other buses. 10 mph zone. Drivers advised to ensure the wear their hi-vis at all times in the bus station and look before exiting the bus.

If you urgently need to use the following interim facility, please inform iBus first.

CODE RED | EMERGENCY RADIO PROCEDURE

If you require the Emergency Services to attend your vehicle (for example in the event of passenger injury, assault or major RTA), you should contact CentreComm using the radio's Code Red facility. To call CentreComm, hold down the Code Red button on your vehicle's radio for at least 3 seconds until you hear a ringing tone to indicate that your call has been connected. Hold down the foot switch in the cab when you are speaking, and end what you have to say with the word "over" to indicate that you expect a response, or "over and out" if this is the end of your communication. Release the foot switch when you are not speaking. Remember to speak slowly and clearly. Note that you will usually receive a radio call from your depot shortly after you make a Code Red call. You should not use the radio whilst the vehicle is in motion.



Call your garage for non-emergency, mechanical defects, help or advise



Call CentreComm for non-emergency, incident reporting or diversions



Call CentreComm for emergency services, passenger injury or assault

EL1 AND EL2 CHANGEOVER POINT



All driver changeovers towards Barking Riverside or Dagenham Dock on route EL1 and EL2, will take place at the new bus stop prior to the existing BUS STOP Q (Waverley Gardens).

This only applies to changeover buses. Once the changeover has taken place, please continue and serve **BUS STOP Q** as normal.

DONTJUST DRIVE...

BEALERT AND BEAWARE OF LOW BRIDGES IN THE AREA



Never divert off route or light run unless authorised by iBus. **Anticipate and always remain alert.**
