

REMEMBER – It is a legal and contractual requirement to switch off the engine when on any Bus Stand

Care and caution when entering and exiting the bus station, there is a high kerb which could possibly cause severe damage to the bus. Also, the area has a high volume of pedestrians that have a habit of walking in the middle of the road.

- Extreme Care and Caution
- Take a wide berth when entering and exiting Stand
- Ensure mirror checks are done
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

St. Leonard's Church



Extreme care and caution while navigating through this junction. It can get very congested and two lanes merge into one.

Solution:

- Be observant of other vehicles trying to cut in front as the lanes merge
- Indicate early making your actions clear
- Straddle both lanes
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Streatham Hill Station / Marks & Spencer's







This stop has a canopy (Street Furniture) that protrudes into the carriageway.

Please do not pull into the Bus Stop at an angle as this will cause a possible collision. If there is a vehicle serving the stop wait behind before serving your allocated bus stop.

- Proceed with caution and show extra care for pedestrians that might be standing under the canopy
- DO NOT pull into the bus stop at an angle, if a vehicle is obstructing the bus stop please be patient and wait until clear

Brixton Station

Heavy vehicle and pedestrian presence.

Pedestrians may wander into the road to pass other pedestrians or attempt to cross at undesignated crossings.

Solution:

- Take great care and attention while navigating through this location
- · Forward planning is essential here
- Follow the 3 "Sees"





Kennington Road Junction / Kennington Park Road







Heavy vehicle and cyclist presence. Vehicles/Cyclists may change lanes without warning.

The lanes are narrow at the traffic lights so extra care must be given when turning onto Kennington Road.

Extra caution must be given as cyclists come from the left cycle lane.

- Be extra vigilant as this is a very busy location.
- Straddle both lanes at the junction of Kennington Road Lambeth
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Kennington Park Road, Lambeth / Post Office









Caution – There are a number of trees which are placed close to the road side or have started to lean into the road, a collision might occur if the bus is positioned too close to kerb.

- Follow the 3 "Sees"
- Approach stops slowly
- Ensure that you don't travel too close to the kerb and look out for overhanging branches
- Report any concerns to an Transport UK Official as soon as possible

Westminster Bridge Road / Waterloo Rail Bridge







Care and caution, Arched Railway Bridge with Bus Lane clearance of 14'6.

At this particular junction, there is a raised surface on entry to the bridge which means buses can drive onto the pavement without realising.

Bollards have been installed to stop this happening.

- Forward planning
- Under no circumstances mount the kerb
- Do not obstruct Yellow Box Junction
- Care and caution

Piccadilly Circus / Regent Street / Lower End







High volume of vehicle and pedestrian presence.

This area is known to be a tourist hotspot and therefore their unpredictable actions from them can lead to a collision.

The junction is generally busy with vehicles and can be confusing, causing vehicles to change lanes which could lead to collisions with vehicles.

- Care and caution
- Plan ahead
- Make sure you are in the correct lane. (Middle Lane)
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Regent Street





Heavy vehicle and pedestrian presence.

Be aware of pedestrians stepping into the road.

Solution:

- Remain cautious of vehicles turning in from Piccadilly or emerging from side roads along Regent Street
- Heavily pedestrianised area, watch out for pedestrians crossing or emerging from behind stationary vehicles
- Unpredictable actions by others (i.e. Taxis and Tourists)
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Regent Street (Top End)



Due to the width and length of NRM's straddle both lanes when turning into Oxford Street.

The area is known to be a very heavy pedestrian area, due to the Oxford Street tube station and is renowned retail shops.



- Straddle both lanes
- Apply care and caution.
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Oxford Street (Towards Streatham)





Extra care & caution throughout all of Oxford Street, as this location is very busy with pedestrians and vehicle, and it is also a Hotspot for shoppers and Tourists.

- Slow and steady
- Follow the 3 "Sees"
- Be extra vigilant with regards to pedestrians and Taxis performing U-Turns

Low Bridge Warning (Battersea Depot)

The bridge height is 13 feet 2 inches therefore the bridge is to be avoided and no attempt to pass underneath or pass near the bridge.



Under no circumstances are you to overtake stationary vehicles waiting to enter the depot as there is significant risk of making contact with the bridge or the bridge supports.



Curtailment Points


From Marble Arch to Streatham Station:

- Westminster Bridge Road, County Hall (Turning Point Only – Buses must not stand)
- Kennington, Vassall Road
- Brixton, Lambeth Town Hall, Effra Road
- Brixton Hill, Holmewood Road (Turning Point Only – Buses must not stand)

From Streatham Station to Marble Arch:

- Brixton, Stockwell Park Walk
- Westminster Bridge Road, Lower Marsh (Turning Point Only – Buses must not stand)
- Trafalgar Square, Northumberland Avenue, South Side
- Piccadilly Circus (Turning Point Only Buses must not stand)

Westminster Bridge Road, County Hall (From Marble Arch to Streatham)




- Set down in Westminster Bridge, bus stop E
- Turn left into York Road, and then turn right onto Addington Street joining back onto line of route
- Picking up at bus stop D

Kennington, Vassall Road (From Marble Arch to Streatham)




- · Set down in Brixton Road at bus stop J
- Proceed along Brixton Road, turning left into Vassall Road
- Turn left onto Foxley Road, left into Cramner Road, and then turning right back onto Brixton Road
- Picking up from bus stop H

Brixton, Lambeth Town Hall, Effra Road (From Marble Arch to Streatham)



- Set down in Brixton Road at bus stop P
- At the fork in the road, bear left onto Effra Road, turning right in the one-way system onto St Matthews Road
- Turn right back onto Brixton Hill, picking up at bus stop X

Brixton Hill, Holmewood Road (From Marble Arch to Streatham)




- · Set down at in Brixton Hill at bus stop BF.
- Turn right onto Streatham Place (A205), circumnavigating the route 45 stand, and pick up back on Brixton Hill bus stop BT

Brixton, Stockwell Park Walk (From Streatham to Marble Arch)




- Set down in Brixton Road, bus stop
- Turn left into Stockwell Road (Brixton o2 arena), turn right onto Stockwell Park Road, past the 109 stand
- Turn right back onto Brixton Road, picking up at bus stop G

Westminster Bridge (From Streatham to Marble Arch)



- Set down in Westminster Bridge Road, at bus stop A
- Proceed to Westminster Bridge, and turn right just before onto York Road
- Turn right onto Addington Road, back onto Westminster Bridge Road
- Picking up at bus stop K

Trafalgar Square, Northumberland Avenue (From Streatham to Marble Arch)



- Set down in Whitehall
- Proceed along Whitehall, circumnavigating Trafalgar Square
- Picking up at bus stop M

Piccadilly Circus (From Streatham to Marble Arch)



- Set down in Regent Street, bus stop Z
- Turn right onto Coventry Street
- Turn right onto Haymarket, picking up at bus stop P

TWO HANDS ON THE WHEEL

Please remember to keep two hands on the wheel at all times.

Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES will one handed driving be tolerated.

If found to be using one hand while being assessed this is an automatic 3A or above.

NRM Rear Door Functioning





Please take extra care when opening/closing the rear doors and allow sufficient time. Rear doors on the early model NRM's open inwards increasing the chance of possible contact with standing customers.

We lose on average £100 for every broken mirror incident!

That includes the cost of the mirror, labour, lost mileage, time off the road for that bus, lost revenue.







These are to assist drivers with their Blind Spots and minimize accidents on the road. As you can see there is a considerable difference in the amount you can see.

Let's aim for Zero Mirror Incidents!

BCES Update: Effort & Communication Is Key

The change aims to put scores back in the control of drivers, it aims to ensure drivers are not penalised when communication is a challenge if the driver has taken steps to improve communication. The measure will no longer focus on how clearly the driver spoke but focus on behaviours. If the driver is having difficulties hearing the assessor, or the assessor has difficulties hearing the driver, the assessor will look

for whether the driver takes any positive action to improve communication. If the driver takes positive action but the assessor is still unable to gain a response to their question, the driver will receive the top score for both Communication and Knowledge. Assessors will play their part, if they don't receive a full response they will repeat their question and / or ask the driver to repeat their response.

Examples of positive actions that assessors will be looking for include:

Leaning closer to the screen to hear better

Closing the window to hear better

Turning cab fan/blowers off to reduce noise

Asking customer to repeat their question

Attempting to confirm customer has heard/understood

In situations where communication is a problem and the driver does not take any positive actions, such as those above, the driver will continue to receive low scores for Knowledge and Communication.
