Rest between duties	10 hours (600 minutes) (can be reduced 3 times per week)	10 hours minimum





Norwood Junction, Grosvenor Road Bus (Stand)





REMEMBER – It is a legal and contractual requirement to switch off the engine when on any Bus Stand

Care and caution due to the bus stand can get rather busy and with limited room to manoeuvre which could possibly cause damage to the bus. Also, the area is a residential area therefore there is a high volume to parked cars.

Solution:

- Extreme Care and Caution
- Ensure mirror / blind spots checks are done
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

West Norwood High Street

Extreme care and caution whilst navigating through the High Street as there are many loading vehicles, as well as cars parked on both sides of the road.

Pedestrians may wander into the road or attempt to cross the road at undesignated crossings and in between parked cars.

- Take great care and attention while navigating through this location
- Slow down and follow the 3 "Sees"



Tulse Hill Gyratory, South Circular Road





The area sees a high volume of vehicles, pedestrians, cyclist and motorbikes as it is a major junction of the A205, South Circular road and retail shops.

Extra caution must be given to vehicles changing lanes as well as, cyclists and motorbike riders.

When pulling out from bus stops, being observant for pedestrian as they tend walk in the road without looking for oncoming vehicles.

- Be extra vigilant as this is a very busy location.
- Care and Caution
- Forward planning is essential at this location

Brockwell Park, Herne Hill

The area sees a high volume of cyclists, motorbikes and there is general usage by cars, lorries, and buses.

Extra Caution must be given to vehicles changing lanes, and stopping suddenly, as well as cyclists not using the designated cycle lane. Motorbike riders often travel on the off side of the bus.

The area also has number of parked vehicles which tend to pull into the road. Vehicles also come out from Rosendale Road, and this distracted drivers where their focus should be by the zebra crossing next to this junction.

- Plan ahead
- Extreme care and caution
- High volume of cyclist and pedestrian presence





Dalberg Road/Brixton Water Lane



The area has narrow roads with heavily parked cars on both sides of the road.

Care and caution are needed when driving in the area because of parked vehicles or those pulling out of a parking space. Pedestrians may cross the road and emerge from between parked cars and therefore vital to proceed with caution.

Also beware of oncoming cyclists as you bare left onto Brixton
Water Lane.

Solution:

- Care and caution
- Caution while navigating this blind corner as cyclist may cyclist tend to ride towards oncoming traffic you
- Drive to the road and follow the 3 "Sees"

Brixton Station

Heavy vehicle and pedestrian presence.

Pedestrians may wander into the road to pass other pedestrians or attempt to cross at undesignated crossings.

- Extreme care and caution at this location
- High volume of vehicle and pedestrian presence. (Pedestrians may appear from behind Buses attempting to cross the road.)
- Follow the 3 "Sees"





Stockwell Road/ Clapham Road



Exercise caution at this junction as there is a yellow box, as there could be a risk of blocking the junction and possibly causing

distress to other road users and causing difficulty in passing the bus.

Extra care and caution at the junction as there is also a high number of E-Scooters and cyclist not obey traffic signals.

Solution:

- Be prepared to stop ahead of entering the junction
- Beware of cyclist or electric scooter not obeying traffic signals
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Lansdowne Way

Two-way road which becomes very narrow when vehicles are parked to one side.

Need to proceed with caution as there will be oncoming vehicles, cyclists, and parked vehicles, which could pose a risk of collision.

As the area is a residential area, there is a risk of a pedestrian being struck should they cross between parked vehicles.

- Care and caution
- Large pedestrian presence
- Follow the 3 "Sees"



Vauxhall Cross / Bus Station



Vauxhall Station has is a very busy and complex junction.

There is high number of road users which include cyclist, pedestrians, vehicles, and other bus services.

As there are various junctions at Vauxhall station there is also an increase in the risk of collisions with street furniture.



- Extreme care and caution at this location.
- Huge vehicle and pedestrian presence
- Please abide to station speed limit 10MPH
- Forward planning lane positioning is key

Elephant & Castle



Multiple hazards entering roundabout as the bus must merge with other traffic across two lanes with vehicles turning left.

Bus must proceed straight ahead on the roundabout towards Newington Causeway where there is normally a high presence of vehicles on the road.

The road layout was changed in December 2015 and with an increase pedestrian crossing and the number of pedestrians present in the area.

There can be heavy pedestrian movements at this junction, so there is a risk of striking a pedestrian. This could lead to major injury to pedestrian if struck, or possible moderate injuries to passengers being thrown forward due to collision or harsh braking.

- Extreme care and caution at this location
- Regular mirror checks are essential at this location
- Drive to the road and be patient
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Elephant & Castle Bus Stand



REMEMBER – It is a legal and contractual requirement to switch off the engine when on any Bus Stand

Lanes marked for cyclists, so caution needs to exercise as there is a risk of collision with a cyclist.

Solution:

- Care and caution at this location
- Follow the 3 "Sees"

Low Bridge Warning (Battersea Depot)

The bridge height is 13 feet 2 inches therefore the bridge is to be avoided and no attempt to pass underneath or pass near the bridge.



Under no circumstances are you to overtake stationary vehicles waiting to enter the depot as there is significant risk of making contact with the bridge or the bridge supports.



Light Running

Depot to Norwood Junction



- Left out of Stewarts Lane onto Silverthorne Road
- Right onto Wandsworth Road
- · Left onto Cedar's Road
- Right onto Clapham Common North Side
- Left into the Avenue South Circular Road
- Follow that into the A205 South Circular Road
- Continue straight ahead which will eventually turn into Poynders Road (Still South Circular Road)
- Follow straight, and the road will change into Atkins Road

- Go straight over the junction of Brixton Hill, which will change into South Circular Road/Christchurch Road
- Turn left into Tulse Hill gyratory
- Remain on the right-hand side, turning right into Norwood Road
- Proceed along Norwood Road, which will then turn into Norwood High Street
- At the fork, turn right into Ernest Avenue, past Norwood bus garage, turning right into Knights Hill
- Proceed along Knights Hill until you reach the junction of Crown Point
- Proceed straight ahead into Beulah Hill
- Follow Beulah Hill all the way down until the road changes into South Norwood Hill
- At the junction of South Norwood Hill / Portland Road, turn right onto A213 High Street
- DO NOT PROCEED INTO PORTLAND ROAD AS THERE IS A LOW BRIDGE
- Take the first left into Grosvenor Road
- Stand

LOW BRIDGE WARNING - SOUTH NORWOOD

Please be aware of the low bridge at the location of South Norwood Hill / Portland Road.

The bridge dimensions are 3.7m / 12'3" so is not suitable for a double decker.

STOP immediately and seek assistance.



Depot to Elephant & Castle



- Turn left onto Silverthorne Road / B224
- Turn left onto Wandsworth Road / A3036
- Turn right onto
 - Bridgefoot / Peckham - Camberwell - Vauxhall
 - Westminster Hwy / A202
- Keep left to continue Kennington Lane / Peckham - Camberwell - Vauxhall - Westminster Hwy / A202 / A3204
- Continue to follow Kennington Lane / A3204
- Turn left onto Kennington Lane / A3
- Continue onto Elephant and Castle turning left onto Southwark Bridge Road. (Similar to the 344 Route)



- Set down in Norwood Road, Bus Stop K (Lancaster Avenue)
- Circumnavigate Tulse Hill one-way system
- Pick up on Norwood Road, Bus Stop G (Tulse Hill Station)

Herne Hill Station (From Norwood Junction, Grosvenor Road)




- · Set down in Dulwich Road, Bus Stop L
- Take the second right into Hurst St, right again at the end into Railton Road, then first right again into Rymer Street
- At the end of Rymer Street, turn left to rejoin Dulwich Road, picking up at Bus Stop N

Brixton, Stockwell Park Walk (From Norwood Junction, Grosvenor Road)




- · Set down at Stockwell Road, Bus Stop C
- Take the first right (Opposite Stockwell Skate Park), and turn right again at the end of the road rejoining Brixton Road
- Pick up at Bus Stop P, Brixton Station

Vauxhall Bus Station (From Norwood Junction, Grosvenor Road)




- Buses proceed into Vauxhall bus station, set down at Bus Stop H
- · Circumnavigate the bus station, picking up at Bus Stop G

Kennington, Kennington Lane (From Norwood Junction, Grosvenor Road)




- Buses proceed from Kennington Lane via Kennington Road, Chester Way.
- Set down at Bus stop KL and continue along normal line of route until the road merges with Kennington Road, at which point turn left onto Kennington Road
- Take the first right onto Chester Way, turning right at the end of the road onto Kennington Lane
- Pick up at Bus Stop KC, Kennington Lane

Herne Hill Station (From Elephant & Castle)



- Set down in Dulwich Road, Bus Stop Z
- Take the first left into Rymer Street, then at the end turn right onto Railton Road, and right again onto Rymer Street
- At the end of Rymer Street, turn right back onto Dulwich Road, picking up at Bus Stop S

Tulse Hill, Hardel Rise (From Elephant & Castle)



- Set down in Norwood Road, Bus Stop C (Thurlow Park Road)
- Circumnavigate Tulse Hill one-way system
- Rejoin Norwood Road, picking up at Bus Stop B

Upper Norwood, Beulah Hill (From Elephant & Castle)



- Set down in Beulah Hill, at Bus Stop SK
- Turn left into Upper Beulah Hill, then at the end of the right turn right onto Church Road
- Then at the end of the road, turn right back onto Beulah Hill
- Pick up at Bus Stop NE (Upper Beulah Hill)

Keep Your Eyes On The Road



It can be tempting to check messages, fill out log cards or eat or drink when stationary, e.g., at red traffic lights.

BUT hazards can appear at any point – you should keep your attention on the task at hand and watch the road ahead.

Highway Code Rule 144: you MUST NOT drive without due care and attention. Driving requires focus and attention at all times.

Highway Code Rule 146: be prepared for unexpected or difficult situations.

Highway Code Rule 148: safe driving needs concentration. Avoid distractions when driving such as reading, adjusting the radio, eating and drinking.

Communication is Key



The benefits to you are:

- You can talk to all your customers at once.
- You feel more in control of the situation.
- Customers see you as a professional.
- You will be asked fewer questions.

The benefits to your customers:

- It gives them control of their journey and allows them to make alternative plans.
- · It makes them feel safer.
- They can let other people know they may be delayed.

Helpful Tips: Think about what you need to tell your customers and the best place to tell them – write down a few important points if it helps and keep the message short and simple.

Also DO NOT answer the radio while the bus is moving.
