## Child & New Deal

Children aged 5 and under 14 years and additional children under 5 years, children aged 14 and 15 years producing a valid Child Rate Photocard, also holders of a valid New Deal Photocard; are charged the fares below for a single journey on one bus.

From 2200 to 0429 daily **Adult fare**

Children of 14 and 15 years not producing a valid Child Rate Photocard, also New Deal participants not producing a valid New Deal Photocard, are charged the adult fare at all times.

## Freedom Passes

**London Boroughs Elderly and Disabled Persons freedom pass** - valid for free travel, except between 0430 and 0859 Mondays to Fridays. Valid all day public holidays.

**Blind Persons freedom pass** - valid for free travel any time. No other freedom passes are accepted on LT services.
