

LONDON BUSES - ROUTE DESCRIPTION

ROUTE 106: Finsbury Park Station - Whitechapel Station

Date of Structural Change: 19 December 2009.

Date of Service Change: 19 December 2009.

Reason for Issue: Durward Street Stand Withdrawn.

STREETS TRAVERSED

Towards Whitechapel Station: Station Place, Stroud Green Road, Blackstock Road, Brownswood Road, Lordship Park, Manor Road, Stamford Hill, Northwold Road, Upper Clapton Road, Lower Clapton Road, Mare Street, Cambridge Heath Road, Sidney Street, Stepney Way, Cavell Street.

Towards Finsbury Park Station: Cavell Street, Raven Row, Sidney Street, Cambridge Heath Road, Mare Street, Amhurst Road, Dalston Lane, Lower Clapton Road, Upper Clapton Road, Northwold Road, Stoke Newington Common, Rectory Road, Brooke Road, Stoke Newington High Street, Stamford Hill, Manor Road, Lordship Park, Brownswood Road, Blackstock Road, Rock Street, St Thomas's Road, Station Place.

STANDING AND TURNING POINTS

FINSBURY PARK STATION, STATION PLACE, EAST SIDE

Private offside stand for 3 buses in marked bays on east side of Station Place commencing outside Flats Nos. 1 and 3 and extending 37 metres south.

Buses proceed from Station Place direct to stand, departing to Station Place. Set down in Station Place, at Alighting Point and pick up in Station Place, at Stop H.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 2 buses on Route 106 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Finsbury Park.
OTHER INFORMATION:	London Buses toilet facilities available 24 hours a day.

CLAPTON POND, LOWER CLAPTON ROAD (from WHITECHAPEL STATION)

Public stand on west side of Lower Clapton Road, commencing 20 metres south of the roundabout at Kenninghall Road and extending 20 metres south.

Buses proceed from Lower Clapton Road direct to stand, departing to Lower Clapton Road. Set down in Lower Clapton Road, at Stop L and pick up in Lower Clapton Road, at Stop E.

AVAILABILITY:	Available from 19:00 until 07:00 only. Buses on Route 106 must not use this stand outside these times.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Clapton Pond.
OTHER INFORMATION:	To be used before 0700 and after 1900 Mondays to Saturdays and at any time on Sundays.

ASH GROVE, BUSH ROAD

Public stand for one bus on south side of Bush Road west of railway bridge.

From Finsbury Park Station.

Buses proceed from Mare Street via The Triangle, Westgate Street, Sheep Lane and Bush Road to stand, departing via Bush Road to Mare Street. Set down in Mare Street, at Stop LE and pick up in Mare Street, at Stop LP.

From Whitechapel Station.

Buses proceed from Mare Street via The Triangle, Westgate Street, Sheep Lane and Bush Road to stand, departing via Bush Road to Mare Street. Set down in Mare Street, at Stop LP and pick up in Mare Street, at Stop Q.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Ash Grove.

WHITECHAPEL, CAVELL STREET

Public stand for two buses on west side of Cavell Street, commencing opposite the entrance to No. 112 and extending 25 metres south.

Buses proceed from Cavell Street direct to stand, departing to Cavell Street. Set down in Cavell Street and pick up in Cavell Street.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 3 buses on Route 106 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Whitechapel.
OTHER INFORMATION:	Council toilet facilities available 24 hours a day.
