ROUTE 157: Crystal Palace Bus Station - Morden Station

Date of Structural Change: 15 November 2008.

Date of Service Change: 15 November 2008.

Reason for Issue: New stand added at Anerley Station.

STREETS TRAVERSED

Towards Morden Station: Crystal Palace Bus Station East Side, Crystal Palace Parade, Anerley Hill, Anerley Road, Croydon Road, Penge Road, South Norwood High Street, Selhurst Road, Northcote Road, Whitehorse Road, St James's Road, Newgate, Wellesley Road, Station Road, Tamworth Road, Road Under Car Park, Drummond Road, Church Street, Reeves Corner, Cairo New Road, Waddon New Road, Waddon Road, Epsom Road, Duppas Hill Road, Epsom Road, Stafford Road, Woodcote Road, Manor Road, Railway Approach, Railway Approach Turning Circle, Railway Approach, Manor Road, Parkgate Road, Park Lane, Carshalton High Street, North Street, Wrythe Green Road, West Street, Wrythe Lane, Rose Hill Roundabout, St Helier Avenue, Morden Hall Road, Aberconway Road, London Road, Bus Only Slip Road, Morden Station Forecourt.

STANDING AND TURNING POINTS

CRYSTAL PALACE BUS STATION

Private stand for 9 buses facing south in marked bays on east side of bus station on east side of Crystal Palace Parade opposite Farquhar Road.

Buses proceed from Crystal Palace Parade via Crystal Palace Bus Station East Side to stand, departing to Crystal Palace Bus Station East Side. Set down in Crystal Palace Parade, at Stop C and pick up in Crystal Palace Bus Station East Side, at Stop D.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	No more than 2 buses on Route 157 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Crystal Palace.
OTHER INFORMATION:	Toilet facilities are available.

ANERLEY STATION (from MORDEN STATION)

Private stand for 5 buses in Bus Parking Area on south side of Anerley Station Road approximately 100 metres north east of Minden Road.

Buses proceed from Anerley Road via Anerley Station Road to stand, departing via Anerley Station Road to Anerley Road. Set down in Anerley Road, at stop AS and pick up in Anerley Road, at stop AC.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Anerley Station.

NORWOOD JUNCTION, GROSVENOR ROAD (from MORDEN STATION)

Public stand on south side of Grosvenor Road (western arm), commencing at a point opposite the western flank wall of No 76 High Street and extending 20 metres south to southern extremity of fire access to flats.

Buses proceed from South Norwood High Street via Grosvenor Road (North Arm) to stand, departing via Grosvenor Road (West Arm), Belgrave Road and South Norwood High Street to Selhurst Road. Set down in South Norwood High Street, at Stop F and pick up in Selhurst Road, at Stop A.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	Norwood Junction.
OTHER INFORMATION:	Drivers must ensure that their vehicles do not obstruct the fire access to the flats.

WEST CROYDON BUS STATION

Private stand for 14 buses in West Croydon Bus Station on east side of Station Road.

From Crystal Palace Bus Station.

Buses proceed from Station Road via West Croydon Bus Station to stand, departing via West Croydon Bus Station and Station Road to West Croydon Bus Station. Set down in Station Road, at Stop B5 and pick up in West Croydon Bus Station, at Stop B6.

From Morden Station.

Buses proceed from West Croydon Bus Station direct to stand, departing via West Croydon Bus Station to Station Road. Set down in West Croydon Bus Station, at Stop B1 and pick up in Station Road, at Stop B3.

AVAILABILITY:	At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS:	Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS:	No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES:	No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY:	West Croydon.
OTHER INFORMATION:	All buses must be fitted with an audible warning reversing device. Toilet facilities are available.

STAFFORD ROAD, THE CHASE

From Crystal Palace Bus Station.

Buses proceed from Stafford Road via High View Avenue and The Chase departing to Stafford Road. Set down in Stafford Road, at Stop WK and pick up in Stafford Road, at Stop EM.

From Morden Station.

Buses proceed from Stafford Road via High View Avenue and The Chase departing to Stafford Road. Set down in Stafford Road and pick up in Stafford Road, at Stop WK.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: **Turning Point Only - Buses must not stand**
DISPLAY: Stafford Road, The Chase.

WALLINGTON, SHOTFIELD (from MORDEN STATION)

Public stand on east side of Shotfield, commencing 51 metres north of Stanley Park Road and extending 26 metres south to a point outside the Health Centre.

Buses proceed from Manor Road via Beddington Gardens and Shotfield to stand, departing via Shotfield to Woodcote Road. Set down in Manor Road, at Stop A and pick up in Woodcote Road, at Stop K.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Wallington.

WALLINGTON STATION (from Crystal Palace Bus Station)

Private stand on east side of BR station forecourt.

Buses proceed from Railway Approach Turning Circle direct to stand, departing via Railway Approach Turning Circle, Railway Approach and Manor Road to Woodcote Road. Set down in Railway Approach Turning Circle, at Stop C and pick up in Woodcote Road, at Stop J.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Wallington.

CARSHALTON, WRYTHE GREEN (from MORDEN STATION)

Public stand on west side of West Street.

Buses proceed from Wrythe Green Road via West Street to stand, departing via West Street to Wrythe Lane. Set down in Wrythe Green Road, at Stop V and pick up in Wrythe Lane, at Stop N.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Wrythe Green.

ST HELIER, ROSE HILL (from Crystal Palace Bus Station)

Public stand on east side of Green Lane, outside Methodist Central Hall, commencing at a point 36 metres south of the centre line of Dorchester Road.

Buses proceed from Wrythe Lane via Rose Hill Roundabout, Green Lane, U-Turn Through Central Reservation At Canterbury Road and Green Lane to stand, departing via Green Lane and Rose Hill Roundabout to Wrythe Lane. Set down in Wrythe Lane, at Stop RL and pick up in Wrythe Lane, at Stop RK.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: Unscheduled curtailments only.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: St Helier.

MORDEN STATION FORECOURT

Private stand for up to 8 buses on Morden Station Forecourt on north side of London Road. Buses proceed from Morden Station Forecourt direct to stand, departing via Morden Station Forecourt to London Road. Set down in Morden Station Forecourt, at Stop N and pick up in London Road, at Stop C.

AVAILABILITY: At any time.
OPERATING RESTRICTIONS: No more than 1 bus on Route 157 should be scheduled to stand at any one time.
MEAL RELIEFS: No meal relief vehicles to stand at any time.
FERRY VEHICLES: No ferry vehicles to park on stand at any time.
DISPLAY: Morden.
OTHER INFORMATION: Toilet facilities available 0430 - 0130 Mon - Sat, 0600 - 0100 Sun.
